


At Roof Sunday

There is no exact date as yet, but the company closes in New York Saturday night and heads for the country. The cast will remain intact: Lucile Watson, Paul Lukas, Mady Christians, George Coulouris and John Lodge.

Mr. Burke also slipped in the information that "Arsenic and Old Lace" will be here late in March. The star players probably will be the same as seen here last season in the same play. Thus, Laura Hope Crews, Eddie Shannon, Erich von Stroheim and Clinton Sundberg. The company at present is touring the east.
