OLD BILL SENT TO ROOSEVELT

Senate Completes Action; Carries \$100,000,000 for Raid Equipment.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 19 (U. P.).—The Senate completed congressional action today on the first deficiency bill, carrying \$100,000,000 for the purchase of air raid and freighting equipment by the Office of Civilian Defense.

The measure now goes to President Roosevelt for his signature. Deficiency items in the measure boost the total appropriation to \$163,789,818. The OCD section requires Senate confirmation of all OCD employees receiving \$4500 a year or more.

Storm Dies Down

The storm which swept through Congress when it was revealed that Mrs. Franklin D. Roosevelt, had been appointed to a \$4600-a-year job in the agency, subsided with the announcement that Miss Chaney had resigned.

Melvyn Douglas, another OCD official around whom much of the congressional fire was centered, is expected to return to Hollywood this week-end to resume his work in the movies. It was indicated that he may return later for further civilian defense work.

Arrangements for the first of five classes in a nutrition refresher course have been made by the Marion county nutrition committee.

Mrs. Vivienne Carter, vocational home economics teacher at Warren Central high school; Dr. Norman Beatty and Miss Louise Braxton, assistant director in charge of home economics in the Indianapolis city schools, comprise the committee.

The class will be held at 10 a. m. Saturday in the state board of health building at the Indiana university medical center. The course is open to all graduate home economists and dietitians in the county. No fee is charged.

Dr. Beatty, chairman, said in announcing the course that "it is hoped that those who complete the series will volunteer to teach civilian nutrition classes in various sections of the city and county."

Dr. Hugh Martin, professor of physiological chemistry at the Indiana university medical school, will lead the discussion Saturday morning on the current knowledge of vitamins.

RCA Official Tells Producers That Schedules Must Be Beaten.

War goods production must not only be completed on schedule but ahead of it, J. M. Smith of the RCA manufacturing Co. warned Hoosier industrialists yesterday.

Mr. Smith is chairman of an advisory committee to the Indianapolis contract distribution branch of the War Production Board. The committee met at the Indianapolis Athletic Club.

Must Overcome Obstacles

"As manufacturers, we should know more about what goes on in Indiana in war production than anyone else," Mr. Smith said. "In spite of obstacles, this job must be done and instead of meeting schedules now set, we must produce ahead of them."
