Airlines to Use Improved Radio Beam

WASHINGTON, May 8.—First installations of a new ultra-high frequency radio beam system for the nation's airlines will be made in a far west area including Salt Lake City, where 17 persons died in last week's plane crash, Charles I. Stanton, acting civil aeronautics administrator, said today.

Mr. Stanton said tests have shown the new type radio guide will

have two major advantages over the radio frequency now used on the airlines.

First, it doesn't break up into multiples that may confuse a pilot, as has happened near Salt Lake and in other areas of rough terrain.

Second, the ultra-high frequency is above the frequency of static. Thus conditions which in the past often have made radio signals almost unreadable may be


