INSPECTION SET
FOR TECH ROTC

21st Consecutive Honor
Rating Sought From
U. S. Army.

Technical high school's R. O. T. C. unit will march onto its parade field a week from today for its annual federal inspection, with the hopes of winning its 21st consecutive honor rating.

Inspecting the regiment will be Lieut. Col. Ernest E. Tabcott, accompanied by Capt. C. A. Pruitt, former Tech R. O. T. C. instructor, now at Indiana university.

The 86-piece R. A. T. C. band will lead the parade and Col. Don Bryan will be at the head of the regiment. Outstanding cadets will be presented with awards after marching onto the field.

Regimental executive officer during the afternoon will be Lieut. Col. Frank Stewart, Capt. Edward Schilling, who will have the duties of adjutant, and Capt. Robert Wheasler, officer of the day.

Sergeant Ernest Stringfield is instructor of the unit.

Award to Be Given

The H. F. Marcus award in honor of a former head of Technical high school's electrical department, will be presented June 3 to the boy in the department who has achieved the greatest degree of success. The lapel pin award will be given for the first time this year. Mr. Markus died in April, 1941, after directing the department for a number of years.

Certificates were won by 12 Technical high school girls in the annual stenographic contest held at the school this week. Edythe McClain, Doris J. Rose and Patricia Frank won awards in the unrestricted class. In the stenography III contest Marian Wiggins, Jean Rodger and Janet Du Granrat won certificates. Six Technical high school science students have taken the Science Clubs of America examination which is aimed at finding science talents which will be of value to the nation in war and peace.

The 40 pupils high in the national contest will go to Washington for the final examination. The high boy and girl in the final contest will receive Westinghouse science grand scholarships of \$2400.




