

## 2,000 to See Golden Clovers

CHICAGO, March 31 (U. P.).—Golden clover boxing, an incubator for ring greats like Joe Louis, Barney Ross, Tony Zale and "Sugar" Robinson, reaches its annual climax tonight when the inter-city matches are held.

Young and ambitious fighters from every section of the nation excepting the far west, battled their way through a long series of elimination meets to gain places on the teams that carry the official designations of New York and Chicago.

Approximately 20,000 fight fans are expected to jam the Chicago stadium to watch the 16th renewal of this amateur mitt classic. The series was inaugurated in 1928 and Chicago holds a wide edge in it with eight victories, four defeats and three ties. The Windy City representatives haven't dropped a match in which they were the host team since 1929 and are favored to protect that record tonight.
