

ROBERT ARDEN BEGS
TO REMAIN IN U. S.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 7 (U. P.)—Rudolf Klinger, better known to radio audiences as Robert Arden, asked the house immigration committee yesterday to approve a bill which would allow him to remain in the country.

Klinger said he had been in this country 10 years, but was banned from permanent admission due to his inability to secure a passport or birth certificate from his native Austria where the Nazis have declared him legally dead.

Action on the bill to grant him a special permit, introduced by Rep. John Costello (D. Cal.), was postponed pending a full report from immigration authorities.

Because of his insecure immigration status, Klinger said, he had been rejected for special work in the army adjutant general's office, where his knowledge of 16 languages would be helpful to the war effort.

CANADIANS TACKLE
NEWSPRINT RELIEF

OTTAWA, Oct. 7 (U. P.)—Recommendations of the inter-departmental committee on labor priorities concerning the position of the Canadian pulp and paper industry soon will be in the hands of the national selective-service director, Arthur MacNamee.

The recommendations, it was said, call for a stepping up of the industry's priority rating to a position where pulp and paper workers will come within the scope of the recently announced labor regulations.

(Under these regulations manpower is "frozen" in "A" or "B" categories, and workers may not quit their jobs without prior consent of a selective service office.)

The committee was said to hope this step would at least insure continuance of the present flow of pulpwood to newspapers and other users. But there was no indication that the government intended to divert manpower from other less essential industries to overcome the anticipated shortage this year of about 1,000,000 cords of pulpwood.
