# FRENCH WANT EQUAL VOICE

De Gaulle Spokesman Says Full Share Desired in German Control.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 7.—The French provisional government of Gen. Charles de Gaulle will be satisfied with nothing less than full and equal representation with the Big Three powers on the European

advisory commission or any future control organization set up for Germany, it was learned today.

A spokesman for the French group here pointed out that the war in Europe is near an end and that France, the nearest big neighbor of Germany and with one of the biggest stakes in Germany's future, is "still out in the cold."

Dislike Connally Remarks The French have a full and equal voice on the Italian advisory commission and Frenchmen point out that their interest in the work of the European advisory commission on Germany is of far greater importance to France.

The spokesman said the French delegation here has not received any reports that the allies have offered to let the French provisional government submit to the advisory commission in writing its ideas on armistice terms and control plans for Germany. But he made it plain that the French would reject such indirect access to German affairs.

Charges 'Unbecoming' Remarks made in the senate this week by Chairman Tom Connally, (D. Tex.) of the senate foreign relations committee only aggravated the allied-French situation in the eyes of Frenchmen.

Connally asserted that France had played "the part of a little

country" and "a very sorry spectacle" in this war.

French spokesmen contended that such charges were unbefitting especially to a people that played such a heroic role through resistance movements in recent weeks in their own liberation—and after more than four years of subjugation by the Germans.

Allied officials, however, were understood to have no plans for changing the present setup of the European advisory commission. If eventually it, or a German control organization, is put on a multinational basis, France would be included as a member.
