

SHORT SHORTS

PARIS, Sept. 30 (U. P.)—Thousands of Parisians were treated to a movie-style rescue yesterday when T. Sgt. Stuart G. Jensen, Natick, Mass., stood on the running board of a speeding American ambulance and snatched a pretty 16-year-old girl from the back of a runaway horse near the Arc de Triomphe.

WASHINGTON—War spending thus far in the current fiscal year to date is more than double net income from all sources, treasury figures disclosed. Average daily war spending since July 1 is \$273,564,000, more than \$15,500,000 in excess of daily war spending in the corresponding period last year.

CHICAGO—Brig. Gen. Robert H. Wills, assistant chief of the office of army transportation, said that sick and wounded soldiers brought home from all theaters of war since Pearl Harbor totaled 130,000.

NEW YORK—The traffic in Christmas gifts between civilians and soldiers overseas is anything but one way, the army revealed after counting more than 150,000 order blanks received from doughboys.

WASHINGTON—A billion-dollar program to double the number of airports in the United States with emphasis on fields for private flyers will be presented to congress next week, according to Theodore P. Wright, new civil aeronautics administrator.

WATERVILLE, N. Y.—Thousands of American M-3 sub-machine guns, fitted to fire 9-mm German ammunition instead of regulation .45 bullets, are today being supplied to the European underground, it has been revealed here by Brig. Gen. A. C. Gillespie, Waterville arsenal commander.

MURFREESBORO, Tenn.—More than 100 Murfreesboro families were evacuated from their homes today as a result of flood waters overflowing from Stone's river after 18 hours of heavy rains.

NEW YORK—Funeral services for Frederic E. Williamson, retired president of the New York Central railroad who died yesterday, will be held at the Church of the Covenant, Cleveland, O., at 2 p. m. Monday.

WASHINGTON—Last-minute agreement of telephone employees to await action of a war labor board panel on their wage demands averted a major tie-up in the capital's communication system last night although long distance and local calls were restricted for about half an hour.

WASHINGTON—A threat to strike the huge Chicago stockyards has been made by the United Packinghouse workers (C. I. O.) over the alleged refusal of the management to obey war labor board directives ordering maintenance of union membership and other provisions.
