Catalonia in Open Revolt, Spanish Republicans Claim

A Spanish Republican broadcast from Southern France said today that Catalonia and other parts of Spain were in "open revolt" against the Franco government, but Madrid reported regular army troops had broken the only known uprising in the Aran valley.
"The time has come for the supreme attack," a spokesman for the "National Union," organized in France to oppose the Franco government, said in a broadcast over the Toulouse radio to inhabitants of Catalonia, the northeast corner of Spain.
"Help the forces of the glorious guerrilla fighters for the reconquest of Spain," the spokesman said. "Rally Catalan forces quickly. Rally and fight!"
Symbolic of "Revolution"
The speaker asserted that Cuba, Colombia and Uruguay had broken off diplomatic relations with the Franco government.
"This action is symbolic of the revolution and horror felt through-

CRACK NAZIS' DUTCH ANCHOR

British Trap Threatens
60,000 Germans in
Holland.

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS, A. E. F., Paris, Oct. 24 (U. P.).—Berlin reported that American reinforcements had moved up to the Aachen front for a new Rhineland offensive expected soon.

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS, A. E. F., Paris, Oct. 24 (U. P.).—The British 24 army cracked into the German anchor bastion of 'S Hertogenbosch, key to the main escape routes for 60,000 to 70,000 enemy troops in southwest Holland, today and front dispatches said resistance appeared to be crumbling.
Troops and tanks fought into the northeast outskirts of 'S Hertogenbosch, 62 miles northeast of Antwerp, during the night and soon after dawn reached the canal running through the city proper. Two other columns were within three miles or less of the city from the east and south.
United Press War Correspondent Ronald Clark reported from the front that the Germans apparently were preparing to abandon the city despite their stubborn resistance on its approaches. No large numbers of German tanks or anti-tank artillery have been observed in the area, he said.

Fall Expected Soon
(A. B. B. C. correspondent at the front said the fate of 'S Hertogenbosch "well may be decided today."
The Canadian 1st army again sealed the entrance to Beveland and Walcheren islands in the Schelde estuary with a drive across the escape railway and highway west of Woensdracht, bottling up the enemy garrisons. The Canadians once before severed the escape lines.
To the southeast, Lt. Gen. George S. Patton's 3d army doughboys were revealed to have captured three-quarters of Malsheers Les Metz, five miles north of Metz itself, in a 17-day room-to-room battle.

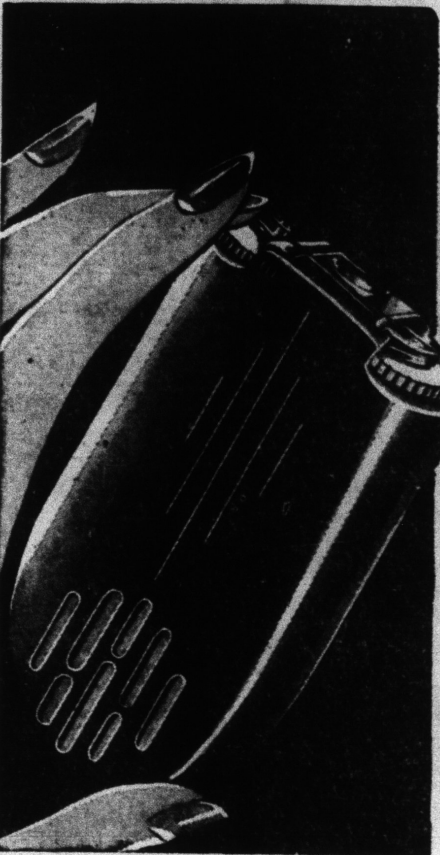
Reveal All Classes in Guatemala Revolt

GUATEMALA CITY, Oct. 24.—The full story of last Friday's 12-hour bloody revolution, in which tanks and other modern weapons of war were used to overthrow the provisional government of President Federico Ponce, can be revealed now with the establishment of a firm democratic regime that is growing stronger every hour.
It was a brilliantly executed coup by young army officers, students, workers and citizens of all classes that ousted the 108-day-old Ponce government.
The coup started early in the morning when young army officers took control of strategically placed barracks and seized their armaments, including tanks and guns.
With the modern weapons distributed among the revolutionary forces, they marched to the presidential palace where they engaged the guards. A fierce battle raged for several hours before President Ponce capitulated and a white flag was run up from the palace. Many persons were killed and wounded.
The enraged populace stormed the homes of several Ponce supporters and destroyed them. Among the buildings attacked were those owned by Luis Mendizabal, president of the legislative assembly; Julio Quinones, a 250-pound woman known as "La Maciste" and one of the closest collaborators with former President Jorge Ubico; and former Police Chief Gen. David Ordonez, who now is in exile at San Francisco.

Ration Calendar

MEAT—Red stamps A8 through Z8 and A5 through K5 in Book 4 good indefinitely for 10 points each. L5, M5, N5 and P5 became good Sunday.

CANNED GOODS—Blue stamps A8 through Z8 and A5 through R5 in Book 4 good indefinitely for 10 points each. S5 through W5 become good Nov. 1.

SUGAR—Stamps 30, 31, 32 and 33 in Book 4 are good indefinitely for 5 pounds. Stamp 40 in Book 4 good for 5 pounds of canning sugar. Applicants applying for canning sugar should send in one spare stamp \$7 attached to the application for each applicant.

GASOLINE—Stamp A-13 for 4 gallons through Dec. 21, B4 and G4, B5 and C5 good for 5 gallons; T (4th quarter) good for 5 gallons through Dec. 31, E, E1 and E2 good for 1 gallon; R, R-1 and R2 are good for 5 gallons but are not valid at filling stations. E and R coupons will expire Oct. 31.

SHOES—No. 1 and No. 2 "airplane" stamps in Book 3 good indefinitely. Airplane stamp 3 in Book 3 will become valid Nov. 1.

TIRES—Commercial vehicle tire inspection every six months or every 5000 miles. B card holders are now eligible for grade 3 tires if they can prove extreme necessity. All A holders are eligible for grade 3 tires, if they find tires which may be purchased.

FUEL OIL—Period 4 and 5 coupons valid through Aug. 31, 1945. All change-making coupons and reserve coupons are now good. Fuel oil rations for 1944-45 heating season now being issued. Period 1 good immediately.
