Yank's Epic: Four Big D-Days, Three Little Ones, Four Wounds

AT A U. S. ARMY HOSPITAL IN ENGLAND, Nov. 2.—This story is incomplete because this guy Glenn doesn't talk much and Cpl. Powers only had a few minutes with him to boot, but if things are dull around the Pentagon building some afternoon, I suggest that the war department look up Glenn and see if they haven't got a medal in stock that will fit him, maybe.

These are Powers' notes, and not mine.

Pfc. Paul Glenn, age 21, married (his wife's name is Alva), address, Lafayette, Ga., has gone home. Before he boarded a hospital ship, Powers, in line of duty as an army public relations correspondent, interviewed him on a tip from an imaginative major named Gorgon Hoople, Syracuse, N. Y., who had been treating him for partial deafness. (For the record, Powers' first name is Edward and he lives in Somerville, Mass.)

Taps Nail Phone

Well, this Glenn was inducted into the army in January, 1942, Dixie drawl and all. Since then he has toted a gun through Africa, Sicily, Italy and France. He has participated in four big D-days, and three little ones. He has been wounded four times and has eavesdropped on a German officer's telephone conversation in a pillbox in the Siegfried line. He was in the infantry, and his last outfit was

the 47th regiment of the 9th di-

vision.

The last time Paul was wounded

in a German frontier town. A

240-mm. shell exploded in the street

killing two of his buddies. The

blast wrenched him from the ground

and pitched him to the top of a

building 25 feet high. The concussion

hurt his ears, and the landing

injured his legs.

About those D-days. Paul's first

di- was naturally North Africa. Then

Sicily. Then Anzio. And Normandy.

The little D-days were Lt. Gen.

Omar N. Bradley's breakout at St.

Lo, the start of the offensive in Bel-

gium, and the assault against the

Siegfried line.

The outfit Glenn landed with in

Normandy caught the Germans on

maneuvers. They took 600 prisoners

after a bitter engagement.

The eavesdropping episode was

after Glenn's unit had captured a

Siegfried pillbox with the switch-

board intact and the telephone

working.

They took turns listening in on

the conversation between the Ger-

man regimental and company com-

manding officers.

Through a naturalized German

acting as interpreter, Paul's major

ordered the Germans to surrender

on the phone. The colonel refused.

The major replied by shelling the

regimental command post, killing

125 Germans.

You can believe it or not, but ac-

cording to Maj. Hoople, his doctor,

Paul objected to going home. He

said the war wasn't over for him yet,

and he wanted to get back to his

outfit.

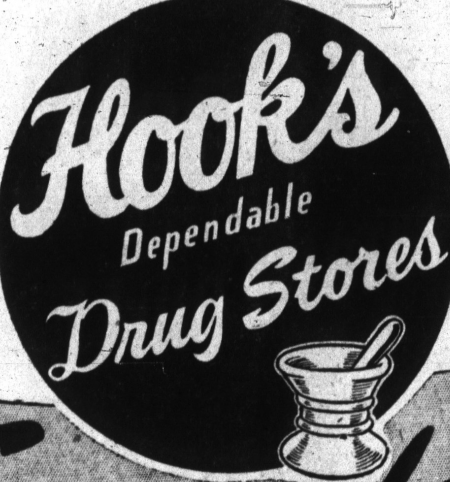

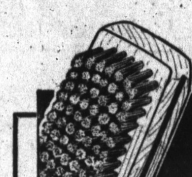
