

## 'SOVIETS CROSS DANUBE'-NAZIS

Report Russ Also Now in Transport Hub 31 Mi. From Budapest.

LONDON, Nov. 13 (U. P.)—Berlin said today that strong Russian forces had smashed into Jaszereny, big transport center 31 miles east of Budapest, and Moscow reported that the Red army had established a firm bridgehead across the Danube just below the Hungarian capital.

By Russian and German account, Marshal Rodion Y. Malinovsky's drives to outflank Budapest were developing steadily, and Moscow said the outskirts of the city were under steady Soviet gunfire.

The Nazi acknowledgement of the Soviet penetration of Jaszereny, key base guarding the eastern approaches to Budapest, indicated that the city soon would be besieged from that direction as well as from the south.

A Moscow communiqué disclosed that 200 German officers and men were killed in East Prussia in a sharp reconnaissance battle on an undisclosed sector.

(Berlin reported that the Soviet reconnaissance thrusts were the prelude to resumption of the Russian offensive along both sides of the rail line leading to Königsberg, capital of East Prussia.)

## TOKYO PLANS STATE FUNERAL FOR PUPPET

A state funeral was being planned at Nanking today for Wang Ching-Wel, 65, puppet president and premier of the Chinese Nanking government, whose death in Japan Friday was announced Sunday by the Japanese Domei news agency.

Shortly after announcing the death Domei reported in another dispatch, also recorded by FCC, that the puppet central political council had appointed Chen Kung-Po, former head of the legislative Yuan of the Nanking government, as "acting president" and also as Wang's successor as premier and chairman of the military council.

Wang's death was said to have followed a long illness which developed from a bullet wound suffered in an assassination attempt in China several years ago. He underwent an operation in China for removal of the bullet, but his condition failed to improve and he went to Japan last March for special treatment.

Wang once was a leading disciple of Sun Yat-Sen, father of the Chinese revolution, and was high in the councils of the Kuomintang, the Chinese national party.

## SINCLAIR LEWIS' SON IS KILLED IN ACTION

NEW YORK, Nov. 13 (U. P.)—Lt. Wells Lewis, 27-year-old son of novelist Sinclair Lewis and Mrs. Grace Hegger Lewis, has been killed in action in France, the war department informed Mrs. Lewis last night. He had served also in North Africa and Italy.

News of Lt. Lewis' death, on Oct. 29, also was relayed to Dorothy Thompson, newspaper columnist and radio commentator, former wife of Sinclair Lewis. Mrs. Thompson canceled her regular radio broadcast.

## BOY HURT IN JUMP OFF OF STREETCAR

Arthur Parker, 13, of 5751 University ave., was injured today when he jumped off the side of a streetcar in front of 802 E. Washington st. He was taken to City hospital.






