## CARMELITES SET VEILING SERVICE

Archbishop-Elect Ritter to  
Conduct Rite Friday  
Morning.

One of the first official acts of the new archbishop-elect of the recently indicated Catholic archdiocese of Indianapolis will be to confer for the "black veil of the professed" upon two sisters of the Carmelite order Friday morning.

The Most Rev. Joseph E. Ritter, archbishop-elect of the archdiocese of Indianapolis, will thus officiate at the public ceremony of the veiling of Sister Angela of the Eucharist and Sister Dolores of Jesus Crucified. Preceding the veiling, the archbishop-elect will offer mass at 9 a. m., Friday, in the monastery of Discalced Carmelite nuns on the Cold Spring rd.

Sister Angela and Sister Dolores entered the monastery five years ago and have now completed their years of probation. In November, 1940, together they received the brown habit of the order and in the following year made their temporary vows for three years. Previous to the veiling and in the presence of their associate nuns only, they will make their final vows Friday morning.

Sister Angela is the former Miss Jean Macy, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. George Macy, Chicago. Sister Dolores and her parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Rogers, are also from Chicago. Friday, Saturday and Sunday, the two sisters will receive visitors in the monastery speaking room.

Elmer Steffen will direct the music and the Rev. Fr. Edwin Sahn will preach the sermon at the services Friday. The nuns speak of the day as "the feast of Carmel's great Doctor of Prayer." St. John of the Cross.

## TRAVELERS AID CHIEFS NAMED

Claycombe Succeeds Walker as President; Wakeman Head Speaks.

Lloyd D. Claycombe, circuit judge-elect, was chosen president of the Indianapolis Travelers Aid society yesterday, succeeding Evan B. Walker.

Col. Haskett L. Conner, commandant of Wakeman General hospital, Camp Atterbury, spoke at the luncheon meeting at the Columbia club.

Other new officers are Judge H. Nathan Swaim of the Indiana supreme court, vice president; Miss Bertha Cleming, secretary, and William H. McKittrick, superintendent of the Indianapolis Union Railway Co., treasurer. The officers were elected for one year.

### Board of Directors

Members of the board of directors, named for three-year terms, include Police Chief Clifford E. Beeker, Mrs. Dorothy Buschmann, Thurman A. Gottschalk, director of the Indiana department of public welfare, and Mr. Claycombe.

Col. Conner discussed methods used at the hospital to recondition wounded and mentally ill members of the armed forces to prepare them for an orderly adjustment to civilian life.

In discussing mental cases treated at Wakeman hospital, he declared, "Nobody knows or can describe what these men have gone through." Although the hospital has been in operation only a few months, "it already is paying dividends insofar as helping the men is concerned," he said. "We are getting good results."

**STALIN TELLS POLES TO SEEK NEW ALLIES**

MOSCOW, Nov. 22 (U. P.)—Marshal Josef Stalin believed Poland should seek allies not only in the east but also in the west, specifically Britain, France and the United States, an official Tass agency dispatch from Lublin said today.

The dispatch said Stalin had made this statement to Marian Spichalski, mayor of Warsaw, who has just returned to Lublin after conferring with Stalin in Moscow.

Spichalski said he described to Stalin and foreign commissar V. M. Molotov the destruction in Warsaw and was promised Russian aid in the restoration of the Polish capital.

## Bishop of Metz Returns After Four Years of Exile

WITH THE U. S. 3D ARMY IN METZ, Nov. 21 (Delayed) (U. P.)—French ecclesiastical law returned to this embattled city today even while German troops still were battling in isolated strong points to delay their inevitable surrender.

Crowds of French men and women lined the streets of the city to welcome back Msgr. Heinz, the bishop of Metz, who became famous throughout France in the early days of the Nazi occupation for his opposition to Adolf Hitler.


No one knew the bishop was returning to Metz and it took the crowd several minutes to recognize the prelate as his car entered the city.

Msgr. Heinz entered the town hall directly opposite the cathedral and appeared on the balcony, where he called on the people to sing the "Marseillaise."

Even as they sang, the last Germans inside the nearby police prefecture surrendered to a group of Americans, while other Nazis continued to fight on the islands of Chambiere and Sauley, located between the canal and the Moselle river.

This was the bishop's first visit to his see since Hitler banished him to Lyon in 1940.
