The selections: Ends, Phil Tinsley, Georgia Tech, and Paul Walker, Yale; tackles, Don Whitmore, Navy, and John Ferraro, U. S. C.; guards, John Green, Army, and Bill Hackett, Ohio State; center, Caleb (Tex) Warrington, Auburn; quarterback, Edgar Kenna, Army; halfbacks, Bob Jenkins, Navy, and Bob Fenimore, Oklahoma A. & M. and fullback, Les Horvath, Ohio State.
