

Anderson Team Captures Sixth NCC Carnival

It was victory time again for Coach Carl Bunge's Anderson Indians who hung up their sixth consecutive North Central conference track meet championship yesterday with a total of 563.5 points in the 18th running of the track carnival at Tech athletic field.

Muncie was second and Tech a surprising third in the fast field. The Greendale mile relay team won one of the races in 3:38.2. Bob Freeman of Tech landed in a tie for first in the high jump and Buzz Gordon of the East sides heaved the shot 45 feet 3 inches to win that event. City Champ Jack Perkins lost in the pole vault although he has cleared the bar some three inches higher than yesterday's best by Fred Abbott of Kokomo.

DeVinney, Wilson Star

Fleet Bob DeVinney shared honors with his teammate, John Wilson, to place the Indians to their triumph. DeVinney got an extra round of applause for his efforts in the 200-yard low hurdles trial which he won in the record-breaking time of .22.7 noting out hurdle expert Jack Adams of Muncie—last year's winner. In the final of this event, DeVinney outdistanced Adams to post a .22.8.

DeVinney also captured the 120-yard high hurdles a repeat performance for him in this event in addition to annexing third place in the broad jump.

Adams, who was edged out by DeVinney earlier in the afternoon, came back to triumph over his opponent in the broad jump—an event in which he posted his second win in as many years.

Relays Are Fast

Although they did not set any new records—all relay teams ran better in this category than they did last year despite the fact that a strong north wind tended to slow them down on the long strip of the oval. Jefferson of Lafayette ran the mile relay in 3:34.1—nearly two seconds slower than the conference record set by Anderson in 1943.

Hero Kohwiler, the state's No. 1 quarter miler captured the 440-yard dash in .51.8—slower than the .50.9 in which he has been previously clocked.

Other scores were: Muncie, 37 points; Tech, 35; Jeff of Lafayette, 34; Kokomo, 19.35; Richmond, 16.35; Marion, 16; Logansport, 14; Frankfort, 7.15 and New Castle, 3.

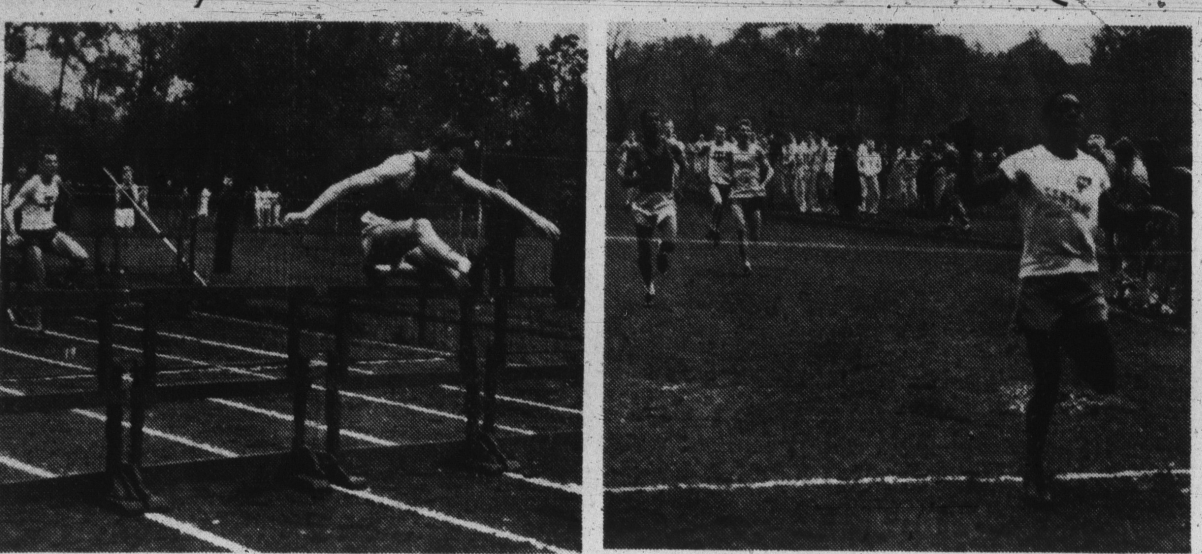

NEW YORK, May 5.—Ossie Bluege's Washington Senators aren't likely to add to life's complexities in the nation's capitol by winning the American league pennant this season, but he was chirping a cheery tune today just the same because the boys are performing beyond expectations.

It wasn't like that a year ago when the Senators were top choices of the experts to dethrone the New York Yankees as champions. Instead, they went in reverse all season and finished in the cellar, 25 games behind the pennant-winning Boston Red Sox.

This year the writers went into reverse themselves and picked the Senators to finish last. Now Bluege figures all he needs to do to complete the cycle is to win the pennant, but he's not that optimistic. He'd settle for a first division berth and he might get it.

The Senators moved into the first division last night by defeating the visiting Philadelphia Athletics, 5 to 4, on the fine "comeback" pitching of Marino Pieretti, a stubby little right-hander from Marila, Lucca, Italy.

Pieretti came to the Senators by way of Portland in the Pacific Coast league where he won 26 games last season. He has been effective in most of his appearances to date this year, chalking up his second victory against three defeats in beating the Athletics.

During the first inning, it looked as if he wouldn't get anything out of the game except an early shower. The Athletics combed him for five hits and four runs, but after that they had no luck in solving his tricky delivery. Meanwhile, the Senators gradually wore down the four-run lead and it was Pieretti
