

90,000 Fans Expected To See All-Star Football Battle Tonight

Redskins Bow Again as Root Rations Hits

COLUMBUS, O., Aug. 30.—The Indianapolis Indians lost another contest last night but they made it close and didn't surrender until the eighth inning when the last-place Columbus Red Birds pushed a runner around the sacks and won, 3 to 2.

It was the Tribesters' ninth straight defeat and they fell another half game behind the league-leading Milwaukee Brewers who divisioned a double header at Minne-

apolis. And the Redskins' other close rival, the third-place Louisville Colonels, lost to the Mud Hens at Toledo.

Charlie Root, Columbus' 46-year-old manager, flipped 'em up for the Red Birds in the series opener last night and held the Indians to four hits, which for some unknown reason is getting to be their daily quota.

Root Fans Five

It was the annual Columbus Zoo Night out at the Red Bird stadium and a crowd of 3936 was on hand to see the Birds snap a five-game losing streak. The home partisans collected eight hits off Pedro Jiminez.

Old Charlie Root struck out five Tribesters and didn't issue a single base on balls. Two errors on the Columbus infield helped the Indians to their first run in the second stanza. The run was registered on a double steal by Stan Wentzel and Heinie Heltzel, the former scoring.

The Indians' other marker was chalked up in the sixth on a triple by Bob Dill who tallied the catch on Artie Park's long fly. Dill got two of the Tribe's safeties.

The Birds registered two runs in the fifth on three hits, a walk, a steal and a scoring fly. The encounter was tied at 2-all when the Birds batted in the eighth.

Hazel Doubles

After one down Vaughn Hazel doubled and scored after two down on Warren Huston's single—and that was the winning run. The Birds have now defeated the Indians nine times in 17 clashes this season.

In the second of the series tonight Jim Wallace, the star southpaw, is slated to pitch for the Indians and Roman Brunswick for the tailenders.

On the long road trip the Indians have dropped 16 games while winning eight. Five games remain to be played on the road, two in Columbus and three in Toledo before the Tribesters return home to meet Louisville in a night double-header on Labor day.

The Indians now trail Milwaukee by 4½ games and are one game ahead of Louisville.
