

JAPS SWALLOW BITTEREST PILL

Sign Surrender of Korea, First Conquest.

IN THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL'S PALACE, KEIJU, Korea,

Sept. 9 (Delayed).—I have just attended a funeral—that marking the death of Japanese domination of Korea and of the first target of Japanese expansion.

Surrender by the Japanese of southern Korea took place in the throne room in the governor-general's palace in Keijo, capital city of Korea. It was the first surrender of the Pacific that was signed indoors.

Today's whole proceedings lasted only 14 minutes. The five signatories signed surrender terms in triplicate—in English, Japanese and Korean.

Japanese land and naval forces were relinquished by the signings of Lt. Gen. Yoshio Suzuki, commander-in-chief of the Jap army forces, and Vice Adm. Gisaburo Yamaguchi, commander-in-chief of the Chikai naval base.

Jap military control of civil affairs ceased after the signing of Gen. Nobuyuki Abe, military governor-general of Korea and former premier of Japan.

Koreans Cheer Americans
Signatories for the allies were Lt. Gen. John R. Hodge, commander-in-chief of the 24th corps, on behalf of Gen. Douglas MacArthur and Adm. Thomas C. Kincaid, commander of the U. S. 7th fleet.

Thousands of wildly cheering Koreans lined the long, wide main street as American forces, led by Hodge and Kincaid, drove to the governor-general's palace where the final Japanese capitulation in Korea was completed.

Hundreds of navy planes from a carrier at anchor in the bay, off Jinsen, roared overhead and American G. I.'s and Japanese civilian police mounted guard.

With the signing, the Japanese tasted the bitterest pill of all surrenders. It meant the loss of a hitherto independent country which had been exploited for 40 years.

Ration Calendar

MEAT—Red stamps V2 through Z2 good through Sept. 30. Stamps A1 through E1 are valid through Oct. 31. F1 through K1 will be good through Nov. 30. L1, M1, N1, P1 and Q1 will be good through Dec. 31. Meat dealers will pay two red points and 4 cents for each pound of waste fat.

SUGAR—Stamp 38 is good for five pounds.

Canning sugar forms are available at ration board. Spare Stamp 13 in Book 4 must be submitted with application for each person listed. All applicants must establish eligibility for canning sugar.

SHOES—No. 1, No. 2, No. 3 and No. 4 "airplane" stamps in Book 3 good indefinitely.
