HOLLYWOOD, Jan. 1 (U. P.)—

Mrs. Carmen Castillo Cugat, 40, who lived in "lavish style" during 16 years of marriage with orchestra leader Xavier Cugat, sued today for enough alimony to keep on living that way.

Mrs. Cugat's separate maintenance suit said that the 45-year-old rumba band leader earned more than \$200,000 in 1945. She charged mental cruelty.

The Cugats were married last Oct. 17, 1929, and separated last Aug. 3. They have no children. Mrs. Cugat is a native of Mexico and her husband was born in Spain.

Mr. Cugat has denied reports that he planned to marry actress Lorraine Allen, but added that his future plans were unpredictable.



FRED HOKE TO HEAD RED CROSS DRIVE

A prominent Indianapolis business and civic leader, Fred J. Hoke, will head the American Red Cross 1946 fund campaign here.

Vice president and general manager of the Holcomb & Hoke Co., Mr. Hoke was chief deputy director for the war production board in the Chicago district in the war years.

He was chairman of the industrial division of last year's Red Cross fund that far exceeded its goal.

4 KILLED IN PLANE CRASH AT LA PORTE

LA PORTE, Ind., Jan. 1 (U. P.)—The pilot and three passengers were burned to death late yesterday when a Michigan Central Airlines plane crashed in a blinding snow storm seven miles north of here.

The plane, en route from Chicago to Flint, Mich., burst into flames after striking the ground. It was more than two hours before state police were able to recover the charred bodies.

The victims were identified as Leroy F. Treat, 25, Flint, a former army flier, the pilot; Robert Nelson Hall, Detroit; Roland Eugene Seccord, Fenton, Mich.; and Walter A. Bacon, Ishpeming, Mich.

At Flint, officials of the Bishop Flying service said that Secord, recently discharged veteran, had chartered the plane to fly to Chicago to pick up Hall and Bacon, both sailors.
