GOV. GREEN IS MASONS' GUEST

Sees Obligation to Extend Aid to Veterans.

The byword of Masonry, to support one another in laudable undertakings, will be the obligation of all Masons toward returning veterans, Governor Dwight H. Green of Illinois told members of Mystic Tie Lodge 388 at the annual past masters' meeting last night in the Masonic Temple.

"Our greatest obligation would be to provide a sound and happy future for the young people bearing the brunt of the struggle," Governor Green said.

He spoke of the need of more productive action to provide homes for discharged servicemen and their families. The governor blamed the government for "tinkering with our national economy" as the basis for strikes.

Clashing Policies
"Price policies, wage policies and tax policies, all perhaps nobly conceived, have worked at such cross purposes that labor and capital are unable to find the common ground where they can both prosper," he emphasized.

The third obligation the country has toward veterans is to protect and insure them and their families against future wars by outlawing the atom bomb.

"Our tasks of peace," he continued, "are no more insurmountable than the herculean assignments we have just fulfilled in war." Governor Green stated a definite need exists for a revised foreign and domestic policy with the strength and courage the pioneers had in building the country.

Smith Presides
The unity learned in freemasonry "must be the strength of the America of tomorrow in which our brave sons and daughters shall realize the dreams we share with them," he concluded.

Governor Green was accompanied by Leslie P. Vois, administrative assistant, and Capt. E. F. Van Diver, aid. A native Hoosier, the Illinois executive served as sovereign prince in the Scottish Rite's Valley of Chicago and is an honorary 33rd degree member of the Rite's supreme council.

Wilbur E. Smith, worshipful master, presided at the dinner.

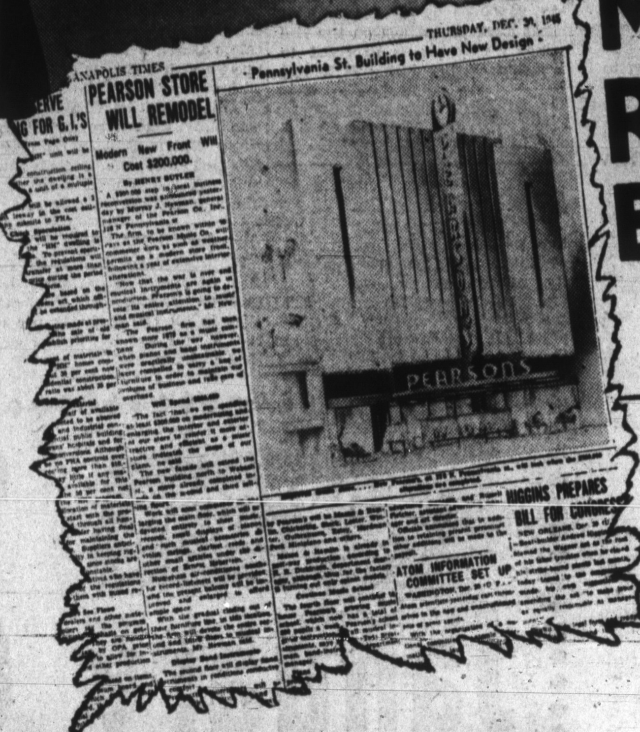
He did not say what form the "resistance" would take.
