SEE EARLY ACTION ON PRICE CONTROL

WASHINGTON, Jan. 29 (U. P.).—Administration leaders in congress paved the way today for early action on legislation to continue the price control act for another year—until June 30, 1947.

Chairman Brent Spence (D. Ky.) of the house banking committee said the legislation, requested by President Truman, would be introduced either today or tomorrow. An identical bill will be introduced in the senate within a week.

Rep. Spence said hearings probably would begin next Tuesday with Price Chief Chester Bowles as first witness.

A studio lamp exploded yesterday and sent a shower of sparks on her.

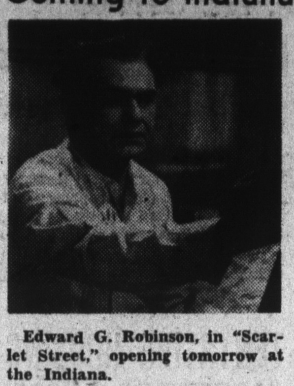
BUTLER SETS FEB. 7 AS FOUNDERS' DAY
