## Housing Lumber Is Covered By Certified Order Plan

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30.—Lumber is one of the tightest construction items at this time. As part of the government's program to see that veterans get housed first, lumber has been put under a priority control plan. Here are some questions about this plan:

Q. Can all kinds of lumber be obtained with a certified order?

A. Only housing construction lumber and hardwood flooring lumber can be obtained on certified orders. Housing construction lumber means softwood, flooring, ceiling, siding, partition, casing, base, moulding, strips and boards, two-inch dimension, finish, shop, and lath. Hardwood flooring lumber means Grades 2 and 3A of hard maple, oak, and pecan, in thicknesses of 3/8-inch, 1/4-inch, and 5/4-inch.

Q. If the standard certification of priorities regulation 7 is used on an order, should the sawmill operator accept it as a valid demand against his production reserve?

A. No, only when the certification provided in the direction is used can the order be considered a certified order under the direction.

Q. What is meant by standard hardwood flooring?

A. Standard hardwood flooring is any hardwood flooring manufactured to conform with the specifications of the National Oak Flooring Manufacturers Association and the Maple Flooring Manufacturers Association.

Q. For purposes of the regulations on priorities for housing material for veterans, what is the difference between a distributor and an office wholesaler?

A. A distributor is any person who buys and stocks lumber for resale, at either wholesale or retail, while an office wholesaler is a person who buys and sells lumber but does not stock.

### SUIT IN ILLINOIS VOTING DISMISSED

WASHINGTON, Jan. 30.—For the

present at least, Illinois congressmen and congressional candidates can stop worrying about the possibility of having to run for election on a statewide basis.

A three-judge federal court in

Chicago dismissed for lack of jurisdiction a suit which, if upheld, would have forced all candidates for the state's 28 congressional seats to run at-large.

The suit, brought by two university professors and an attorney, contended that Illinois voters were not being given equal representation because the state had not been redistricted on a population basis since 1901.
