CIO VS. TROOPS
CASE IS READY

**Union Fights Use of State
Guard Against Pickets.**

Attorneys for the state and for
the C. I. O. will enter the first
round tomorrow of a federal court
fight in which the labor organiza-
tion hopes to enjoin possible future
use of troops against "peaceful"
pickets.

The injunction suit was filed by
the C. I. O. after the governor called
out the state guard recently to up-
hold a court order against picketing
at the Rex Manufacturing plant in
Connersville. Troops and state po-
lice moved in on the Rex strike,
outgrowth of a jurisdictional dispute
between electrical workers of the
C. I. O. and A. F. of L., and enabled
the plant to re-open.

In the jurisdictional dispute, the
C. I. O. sought to break the A. F. of
L. workers' contract with the com-
pany on grounds a majority of the
workers favored the C. I. O. and no
bargaining election had been held.

Appeal to Governor
A circuit court order was issued
enjoining further C. I. O. picketing
and county and local law enforce-
ment officials appealed to the gov-
ernor for aid in backing up the
court action.

In tomorrow's hearing, Federal
Judge Robert Baltzell will hear
arguments on motions to dismiss
filed by the attorney general's of-
fice in behalf of the state officials.
Although the suit specifically names
Governor Gates, state police head
Austin R. Killian and Adjutant
General Ben Watt, state attorneys
contend the action is essentially
one against the state and therefore
illegal unless the state consents to
be sued.

Attorneys Cleon Poust and Robert
Howell Jr., representing the
state, also charge the C. I. O. is
not a proper party to the case.
They have asked Judge Baltzell to
rule summarily for the state and
deny the injunction on the basis
of pleadings and affidavits already
filed.

Should the court deny the sum-
mary judgment sought by the state,
hearing on the merits of the in-
junction suit itself is scheduled for
Oct. 2.

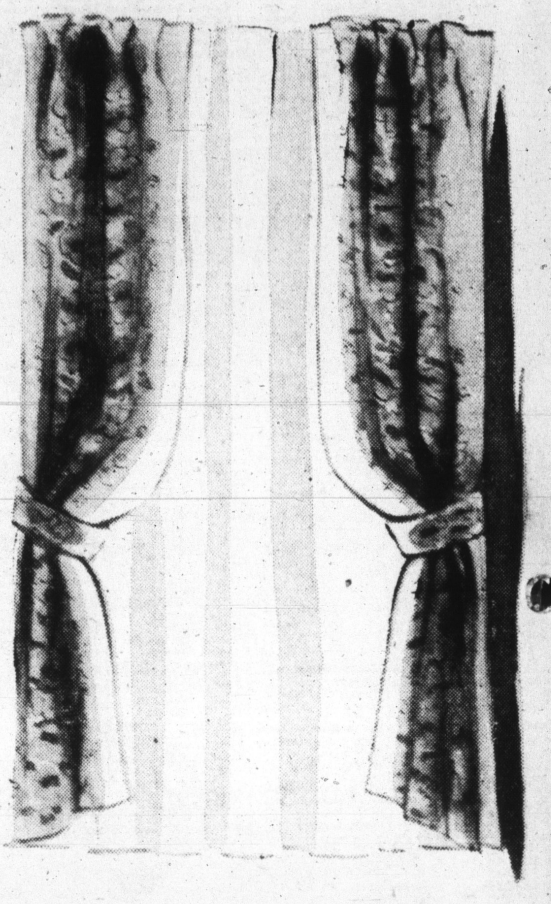

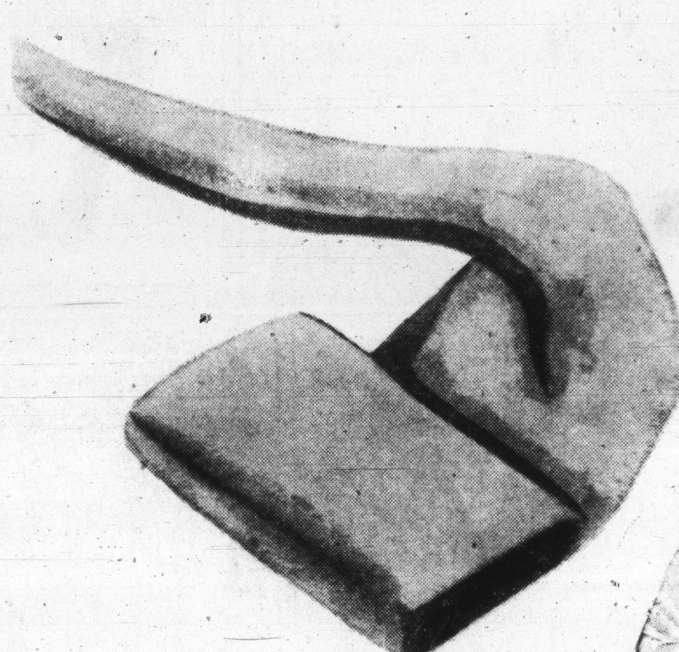

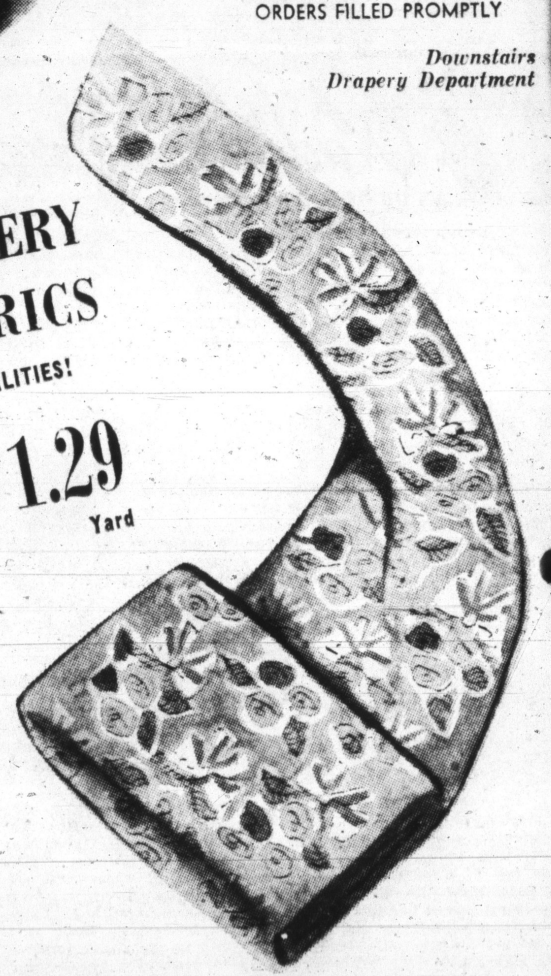
