

**TAX FIGHT SEEN  
IF GOP WINS**

Battle Looms Between  
Truman, House.

WASHINGTON, Oct. 24.—If the  
Republicans do take the house, the  
Truman administration will have  
really hard going with two hard,  
experienced men.

All tax laws and most appropri-  
ation bills get their start in the  
house.

Rep. John Taber of New York,  
who's been in congress 24 years,  
will be appropriations chairman. He  
is already honing his razor on the  
budget.

Rep. Harold Knutson of Minne-  
sota will be ways and means chair-  
man. He knows his way around the  
Capitol, too, after 30 years of it.

Mr. Knutson will insist on his  
plan for 20 per cent horizontal in-  
come tax slash. At the same time,  
Mr. Taber will be hacking at over-  
stuffed government spending.

Strong probability is that the  
house will adopt Mr. Knutson's 20  
per cent tax slash.

The senate likely will pull it back  
to 10 per cent. House will settle for  
that.

But don't look for those addi-  
tions to your pay to be effective  
much before January, 1948.




