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BRAZILIANS FIGHT REDS AND FACISTS

Minister of Defense Proclamation, Directed at Communists, Uses Strong Words on 'Exotic Ideologies.'

(Second of a Series.)

RIO DE JANEIRO, Nov. 27.—The Dutra government, struggling against inflation and food shortages with the creaking mechanism of a new democracy, is in there punching against both Communist and Fascist elements here.
In a recent order of the day, issued by the minister of defense on Brazil's national birthday, strong words were used about "exotic ideologies." The order was directed chiefly against the Communists but it also hit at the old Integralists, now called the Partido Representativo Popular.
Some wondered whether the proclamation foreboded another ban on the Communists, legalized again last year after a nine-year suppression. It was doubted, however, that the Dutra government was ready to go that far, in spite of its worries.
Some members of the government fear a tremendous increase in Communist strength in the elections Jan. 19. There have been estimates as high as 70 per cent of the total vote of six million but that sounds far too high.
Forecasts Million Votes
The Communist leader, Senator Luis Carlos Prestes, forecasts a million votes. In the elections of Dec. 1945, which sent Mr. Prestes to the senate and 14 Communists to congress, the party polled 600,000 votes, or 10 per cent of the total.
The Communists have daily newspapers in such strongholds as Rio, Recife, Santos, and Sao Paulo, and Porto Alegre, and two more papers are scheduled to appear soon.
A recent drive for a half million dollars to finance "a press for the people, strong enough to hinder the reactionary propaganda of the capitalist press" was over-subscribed by \$45,000, according to Communist spokesman. The party also has a number of periodicals and several publishing houses, but no radio station.
Heckling Attacks
The Communist papers are fairly well edited. The one in Rio is balanced and restrained. It follows the party line, employs the usual clichés about "Yankee imperialism" and "imperialist capitalism," but its attacks upon the U. S. are heckling rather than savage.
The papers print considerable local and world news, some sports, fiction, and carry commercial advertising. They admittedly are run at a financial loss.
The Communist party here appears well organized and it has drive. A recent election meeting addressed by Senator Prestes was attended by 10,000 persons, and was orderly. Earlier meetings, held in defiance of the authorities were marked with some bloodshed.
When I left New York a fortnight ago I heard a report of a possible Communist revolution in Brazil. On the ground here, this does
