

Army Hospital Asks for Beds

A request for 800 additional beds to house tubercular patients at Ft. Harrison was made today by the local Veterans Administration. Despite indications by the army that buildings at Ft. Harrison will not be available until March, VA officials are requesting an early transfer. About 500 tubercular patients are already housed at Billings General hospital and the army has indicated that would like these to be transferred to the VA.
