### Plane Casualties Top Auto Toll

#### 2 Fliers Killed, 1 Motorist Dead

Casualties in the air exceeded those in automobile accidents in Indiana over the week-end, with two dead and four injured in four airplane crashes. One youth was killed and another injured in an automobile crash.

Milton C. Weber, 25, and his brother, Gerald, 21, of Monroeville, Mich., were killed when they lost control of their plane in a snowstorm late Saturday and crashed on the Kling Farm three miles south of Ashley in DeKalb county.

Robert Shank, 30, and Nolan Mitchell, 20, both of Trafalgar, were in serious condition in Methodist hospital here after a plane crash yesterday five miles west of Trafalgar.

**Injured in Ambulance**

The ambulance in which Mr. Shank was being rushed to Methodist hospital last night crashed into an automobile at Capitol ave. and Michigan st.

Mr. Shank's mother, Mrs. Edna Shank, 63, of Trafalgar, suffered leg injuries in the ambulance. She was riding to the hospital with her son.

There was no immediate determination as to whether the plane crash victim's injuries were aggravated by the crash.

Driver of the automobile which was in collision with the ambulance was C. T. Sheets, 63, of 2225 E. 10th st., police said.

**Plane Hits Wires**

At Berne, Ind., Milo Lehman, 34, escaped serious injury when the light plane he was flying hit telephone wires over U. S. 27 and State Rd. 124 and crashed.

Julius Henry, 56, an aviation fan of Knox, was in serious condition at the Holy Family hospital at LaPorte. His plane struck high-tension wires over the east runway of the Starke County airport yesterday morning and crashed.

One ground fatality was reported in the state yesterday. Carl Shel, 18, New Carlisle, was killed early in the morning when the car in which he was a passenger crashed into an unlighted truck-trailer parked on State Rd. 30 near New Carlisle.

James H. Gaddy, 17, of New Carlisle, driver of the car, was injured critically.
