

Convict Attacks Woman, Held After Knifing Rescuer

CLEVELAND, July 10 (U. P.).—A 28-year-old convict early today attacked a young mother in her apartment. He knifed and critically wounded her brother and then was captured during a fierce battle.

Police identified the attacker as James Johnson, currently freed on \$2500 bond while awaiting indictment for receiving stolen goods.

Jenner Asks More Flood Control Cash

WASHINGTON, July 10.—Senator William E. Jenner (R. Ind.) today told the senate appropriations subcommittee for flood control that Indiana was not getting its fair share of federal funds.

"We send you hams and get back weenies," he asserted.

Although the Indiana junior senator has been twitted in Washington for the Hoosier G. O. P. stand opposing federal subsidy of states, he asked additional flood control expenditures of \$1 million for Fall creek in Indianapolis; \$1 million for Cagle's Mill reservoir, and \$500,000 for Cannelton.

Clyde Black, secretary of the Indiana flood control committee, and Rep. Ed Mitchell of Evansville, attended the session.

C. I. O. Opposes Universal Drill

WASHINGTON, July 10 (U. P.).—The C. I. O. charged today that the special presidential commission which recommended universal military training was "biased from the very beginning" because it did not represent opponents of peacetime conscription.

Kermit Eby, C. I. O. education and research director, told the house armed services committee that universal training would only take the United States "on the same disastrous path taken by the countries of Europe."

Urging defeat of the training program, Mr. Eby said the cause of peace would be better served if the money involved were given to the various cultural agencies of the United Nations.

Rent Hiked, Buys Grave And Hangs Himself

LOS ANGELES, July 10 (U. P.).—Bertram Colville, 75, had a difficult time making ends meet on his slim income. Yesterday he made a choice and sent his wife down to make a payment on a cemetery plot they owned.

While she was away, Mr. Colville fashioned a noose from a clothesline and hanged himself in the bathroom of his home.

On a dresser police found a note saying the Colvilles' rent had been raised from \$20 to \$50 a month.

Marriage Annulled After Bigamy Charge

ANDERSON, Ind., July 10.—The marriage of Mrs. Betty L. Bentley to Joseph M. Bentley, 36-year-old taxicab firm manager charged with bigamy, was annulled yesterday by Special Judge Everett E. McDaniels.

The Anderson woman sought annulment of the two-month-old marriage after Mrs. Alice M. Bentley, South Bend restaurant operator, charged Bentley had never divorced her.

Steal Hamburger, Cook It on Spot

BAKER, Oregon, July 10 (U. P.).—Don Smith, manager of a local grocery store, told police today that thieves stole some hamburger from the meat counter, then set up their own stove and cooked it.

With the hamburgers they had milk, bread and cheese looted from other parts of the store.

Only a small amount of cash was taken.
