Survey Shows Their Prices Have Lagged Behind Others in General Increases

MINNEAPOLIS, Oct. 24 (UP)—The American housewife was told today that despite high prices, she can feed her family economically and well by serving chicken, corn flakes and spinach.

Those items, a survey showed, are among dozens of types of food which have risen in cost far less than the 105 per cent increase attributed to foods generally since 1939.

The nation-wide survey was made by the family economics bureau of the Northwestern National Life Insurance Co.

The bureau sought to determine what foods, if any, had risen in cost less than the general 105 per cent, and the 130 per cent increase noted in meat prices since 1939. It found a lot of them.

Meat by meat, the bureau discovered that the following items can be purchased by the housewife at prices which have advanced at a rate far below the general level:

BREAKFAST—Canned Apples

duces, up only 10 to 30 per cent since 1939; canned grapefruit and pineapple juice, up 50 to 65 per cent; corn or wheat flakes, up 32 to 37 per cent; rolled oats, up 60 per cent; toast or cinnamon rolls, up 65 per cent; orange marmalade, up 45 per cent; tea, up 40 per cent; milk, up 68 per cent; and cocoa, up 68 per cent.

LUNCH—Canned soup, up 35 to 40 per cent; soda crackers, up 65 per cent; sliced oranges and lettuce for salad, up 68 to 50 per cent; and 50 per cent, respectively; carrots, up 89 per cent; spinach, up 65 per cent; and macaroni, up 40 per cent.

DINNER—Chicken, up 65 to 90 per cent; canned picnic ham, up 33½ per cent; canned peas, up 30 per cent; canned green beans and corn, up 30 per cent; spaghetti, up 70 per cent; pork and gelatin, up 78 per cent; and cakes and other bakery goods, up 65 to 70 per cent.

The survey noted that chicken prices had risen less than those for any other meat.
