CODY, Wyo., Jan. 6 (UP)—A 3215-acre slice of irrigable Wyoming farm land will be parceled out to 31 war veterans whose names will be drawn from a fish bowl here today.

Gov. Lester C. Hunt of Wyoming will draw the first name from the bowl filled with the names of 491 applicants.

More thousands of acres of land are scheduled to be opened next year.

## Butler to Be Host To School Groups

The second session of the Mid-Winter Education Conference Series and a Physical Education Clinic will be held next week at Butler University.

## Cyclotron Gives Birth to Elements

LOS ANGELES, Jan. 6 (UP)—The alchemist's dream of transmutation of elements has been achieved by the cyclotron, which smashes uranium atoms into more than two-thirds of the known elements, a University of California scientist revealed today.

The machine does the trick in a single bombardment.


Dr. Glenn T. Seaborg, chemistry professor of the Berkeley campus and co-discoverer of the atomic bomb element plutonium, described

the most massive transmutation yet achieved to the American physical Society meeting at UCLA. As the uranium atom was split, he said, two other atoms of differing weights were born, each lighter than its heavier uranium "parent." They ranged from elements 26—iron—to the rare earths, elements 57 to 70, and beyond.

"Bullets" used in the bombardment were two types of ultra-high energy alpha particles, nuclei of helium atoms.
