Graebner to Join Butler's Faculty

Prof. H. C. Graebner, former Valparaiso University faculty member, has been appointed head of the insurance division in the College of Business Administration at Butler University.

Prof. Graebner succeeds Dr. Robert I. Mehr, who has accepted a position with the University of Illinois faculty.

Mr. Graebner holds a Huebner Foundation Fellowship in the Graduate School of Arts and Letters, University of Pennsylvania. He is a graduate from Valparaiso University and Northwestern University.

Besides the post on the Valparaiso faculty, Prof. Graebner was with the Westminster College faculty, American Institute of Banking, and has served as supervisor of Chartered Life Underwriters' Study groups in Youngstown, O.

Mr. Graebner is a member of the American Association of University Professors, American Marketing Association, American Association of University Teachers of Insurance, American Society of Chartered Life Underwriters, and the Philadelphia Society of Chartered Life Underwriters.

NEW YORK, Jan. 7 (UP)—May be Richard A. Douglas of Pasadena, Cal., has \$999,999 and just wants another \$1 to make it a million, postal authorities said today.

At any rate they were much interested in a letter Mr. Douglas wrote to Casimir P. Palmer of New York.

Mr. Douglas, who promised to remember Mr. Palmer sincerely, inclosed a stamped, self-addressed envelope. Mr. Palmer, who never heard of Mr. Douglas, sent the letter to the New York World-Telegram, which in turn called postal officials about it.

They suggested the letter be submitted for study. One official said the letter had a familiar ring.

"But it doesn't sound legitimate," he said.


