



Ex-Follies Girl Wants Big Stage

VENICE, Cal., Jan. 7 (UPI)—A
former specialty girl in the Ziegfeld
Follies promised today that she
would make Milwaukee "merrier,
mighier and more modern" if she
is elected mayor.

Mrs. Ruth Foster Foremming said
she will leave today for Milwaukee
to begin her campaign for the job
now held by 80-year-old Mayor John
Bohn.

She is the first woman in the city's
history to file for the office. She
said her non-partisan campaign
would be based on a pledge to in-
crease human and animal welfare
in the city.

Mrs. Foremming is one of 11 can-
didates for the job.

She said she is proud of the fact
that she is a former Follies girl.
She had a part in the 1919 Follies
production of "a pretty girl is like
a melody."

A year after the 1919 Follies,
Mrs. Foremming was selected as the
"prettiest girl in Wisconsin." She
later married Maj. Paul Foremming,
now head of the Veterans' Hospital
at suburban Woods, Wis.
