GREEN COVE SPRINGS, Fla., Feb. 5 (UP)—This town showed today that it wasn't mad at G. B. Mobley, 80-year-old prospector whose excavation crew tore up the main street in a futile search for pirate gold.

The City Commission voted to erect a \$1000 memorial to the prospector.

It will be a 30-foot well, symbolizing the 30-foot hole Mr. Mobley gouged into Walnut St., looking for \$4 million in pirate loot. Topping the well will be a little house containing an appropriate inscription and a painting of a pirate.

Russ Can't Marry Aliens, Soviet Rules

MOSCOW, Feb. 5 (UP)—The Supreme Soviet has approved the interim decree of its Presidium which prohibits Russians from marrying foreigners.

(This decree, issued last autumn, has been the subject of major diplomatic conflicts between the Soviet Union and several countries, including Britain and Chile. Russia has refused to allow Soviet women who have married foreigners to leave the country.)

Senator Accuses Makers of Crisco

Tobey Suspects 'Lust for Profits'

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5 (UP)—Chairman Charles W. Tobey (R., N. H.) of the Senate Banking Committee today charged the Procter & Gamble Co. with a discrepancy between its price on Crisco and its costs that "looks like cupidity and lust for profits."

The firm's sales manager hotly denied the charge.

Sen. Tobey made his charge as T. J. Wood, the firm's vice president in charge of sales, attempted to tell the committee that profits actually were less on a percentage basis than in previous years.

Witness Reddends

Sen. Tobey insisted that Crisco was selling at its highest price in history "while on your own figures" the costs of cottonseed oil and soy bean oil, chief ingredients, were dropping.

"There's a great inconsistency between your prices and your costs," Mr. Tobey said. "It looks like cupidity and lust for profits."

Mr. Wood, his face reddening, shouted:

"I don't think it's due to lust. I don't think it's to take advantage of the public. I don't think you're justified in charging me or my company with taking advantage of the public."

Sen. Tobey countered that "on your own figures you have not supported your case."

Earlier, Mr. Tobey pointed out that the company reported for the last half of 1947 a profit of \$77 million after charges. He said this was equal to \$12 a share on the company's stock and the highest profit in the company's history.

Mr. Wood said he believed the earnings were about \$3 per share, after depreciation and allocations to reserves.

Sen. Tobey's committee is considering anti-inflation legislation.

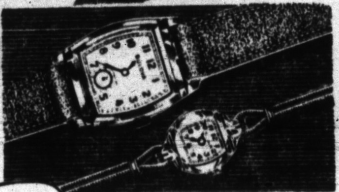

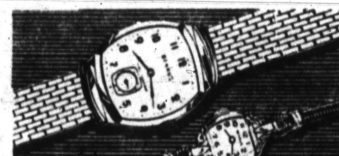
