'New Look' for Dollars

Rejected by Snyder

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5 (UPI)—Secretary of Treasury John W. Snyder takes a dim view of proposals to give the country's foreign money a new look.

Reporters asked him about proposals to print currency in different colors and to call in all currency, now printed in green, and exchange it for new money as a means of smacking out currency held by foreigners.

Said Mr. Snyder: "It would be a costly process and not too effective."
