Charles C. Branson, 5531 Central Ave., died yesterday in Methodist Hospital. He was 57.

Services will be held Thursday in St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church. The time has not been set. Burial will be in Crown Hill.

Mr. Branson was president of the W. H. Bass Photo Co. 28 years and pioneered in photography. He began as an errand boy, joining the firm in 1899. Later he became photographer, artist and retouch expert.

He was manager by 1904 and was elected president and manager here at the age of seven. Later he attended business and art schools here.

Mr. Branson was a member of the Indianapolis and Indiana Chambers of Commerce, the Photographers' Association and Rotary Club. He was a communicant of St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church.

Survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Margaret Abel, Indianapolis, and Mrs. Lucille Betz, Flat Rock, N. C.; a sister, Mrs. Freda Peever, Indianapolis, and six grandchildren.
