**3 Women Seized
 In Prison Escape**
**Freedom Short-Lived;
 Male Friends Nabbed**

Three prisoners who escaped from the Indiana Women's Prison here last night by scaling a wall were captured a short time later at a house in the 1300 block, N. West St.

Two men found with them were held on vagrancy charges pending further investigation. The prisoners were Mrs. Dorothy Lucille Skaggs, 38, of Anderson, serving 10 years for a series of filling station holdups in 1941; Edna Hart, 37, of Bedford, serving 10 to 25 years for robbery; and Clara Dixon, 25, Jeffersonville, serving two to five years for robbery.

Scale Prison Wall
 Mrs. Ethel Krueger, prison superintendent, said the trio disappeared about 6:30 p. m. yesterday, apparently climbing over the wall with a ladder. She said they had been made "trusties" a few months ago under the prison honor system. They had been classified as "model prisoners."

On a tip that the women "had friends" who lived at the West St. address, police went there and waited. The prisoners drove up in a car with two men and officers nabbed them. Board Streetcar

The prisoners said they boarded a streetcar at the prison rode to West Indianapolis and joined a man in a car. They added they picked up another man friend before going to the West St. address. Mrs. Skaggs was known as the "woman in red" during her robbery forays seven years ago.

 Kidnaping Charge**
 Two ex-convicts today faced kidnaping charges in the Mar. 21 abduction of Andrew (Big Perk) Perkins, 38-year-old Indiana Ave. lottery baron.

They are James P. Utley, 39, of 4114 Indiana Ave., and James Southern, 33, of 2738 Boulevard Pl. They are being held under \$20,000 bond.

Detectives turned their attention to Utley after they heard he was spending money freely in "Avenue" night spots. Perkins and an employee were taken to a cemetery west of Indianapolis. Perkins was robbed of \$800, an expensive wrist watch, a pistol and his Lincoln sedan. The pistol, car and watch have been recovered.
