Tighten Safety Measures Since Centralia Mine Blast

Federal Code Written Into Union Contracts; Federal Probers Lack Power to Close Mines

WASHINGTON, Apr. 1—Not much noticed, because of the current coal miners' strike, was the first anniversary of a tragic event in the coal industry.

It was on Mar. 25, 1947, that a mine near Centralia, Ill., blew up, killing 11 miners.

In the year that has gone by it is presumed that mine inspection, by both federal and state agencies, has been tightened. The federal mine safety code has been written into the union's contracts with the coal operators. Congress has not acted on proposals by some of its members to give federal inspectors a power that is restricted to state inspectors—authority to close mines they deem unsafe.

There have been worse disasters in American mining history, but none in which it was easier to find the trail of official negligence and failure to enforce a fundamental rule of mine safety.

State Investigation

A committee in the Senate, headed by Sen. Guy Cordon (R., Ore.), went to Centralia and held hearings. This and other investigations proved that the cause was an over-abundance of coal dust which ignited and exploded.

attention to the Centralia mine, and the director of the mining department, Robert M. Medill, was removed.

Other agencies were involved, including the Federal Coal Mines Administration, then in possession of nearly all coal mines; the Centralia Coal Co., and even the

United Mine Workers—the union

of the miners led by John L. Lewis. Official reports place some of the blame on all of them.
