

## State Plans Auto Checks For Six Weeks

Safety Inspection To Start May 15

Hoosier car owners will be given a chance to have safety features of their cars checked free during a six-weeks safety check program to get under way May 15.

Plans for Indiana to join the nationwide "Check your car—check accidents" program are being made by the Indiana Traffic Safety Commission.

Civic and business groups will be asked to join law enforcement agencies in the drive to have brakes, lights, steering and other safety features of every car in Indiana checked. James D. Harrison, safety council director, said courtesy checking lanes would be set up along state highways.

Plan to Issue Stickers  
Stickers will be issued to motorists whose cars pass the checks, Mr. Harrison said. Where safety defects which might cause accidents are found, the motorists will be urged to have the faults corrected immediately.

Car defects are responsible for one out of five accidents, Mr. Harrison added, and the condition of vehicles involved can be determined in only about half the cases, so the actual importance of vehicle defects as a cause of accidents probably is even greater than that.

Objective of the six weeks drive, he said, is to point out to motorists the danger spots on their cars and demonstrate the importance of keeping cars in safe operating condition at all times.

### City 'Work Out' Grading Problem

The Board of Works said today that City Engineer M. G. Johnson would try to work out a grade adjustment for the proposed sidewalk along the east side of Boulevard Place between 49th and 52d Sts.

Property owners have objected to the grading of the planned sidewalk because many of them would be forced to regrade private driveways and front walks which the sidewalk will cross. The adjustment will have to be worked out. Works Board spokesman said, with the Park Department which has jurisdiction over boulevard rights of way.

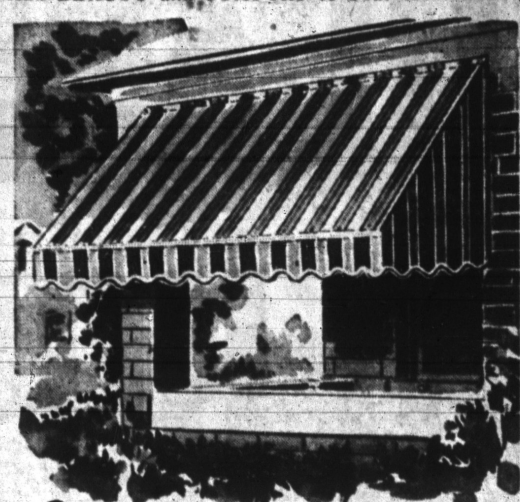
