## Booster Named Tops in State

An all-American rating for superior journalistic achievement last semester has been awarded the Booster, Manual High School bi-weekly, by the National Scholastic Press Association.

## North Side Firm Named Distributors For New Fabric, Plastic Product

**Kuhn Believes Owners Will Save on Costs**

North Side Chevrolet, Inc., 836 E. 63d St., has been named distributor for Celastic Colloid Treated Fabric, new plastic process for repairing automobile bodies and fenders.

With the use of Celastic, Bill Kuhn, president of North Side Chevrolet and East Side Chevrolet, 5436 E. Washington St., believes car owners will save 50 per cent in material costs and up to two-thirds in labor costs.

This is due to the low cost of Celastic, the short time required for body repairs when using this new plastic material and the fact that all North Side Chevrolet body men are being trained as Celastic operators.

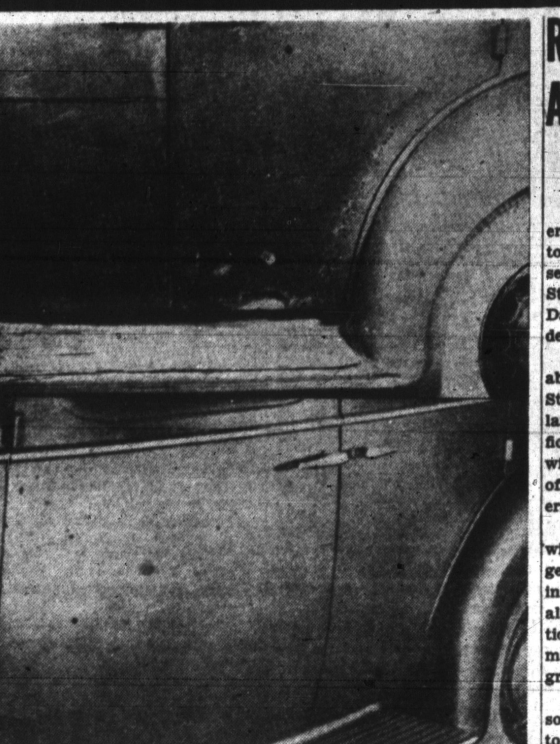
The Celastic plastic process has many advantages. Since it can be applied cold it is adaptable to warped panels, wooden door frames, upholstery and other inflammable materials which prohibit the use of intense heat.

The unusual colloid is a sturdy fabric, impregnated with plastic. It can be placed over a hole or rusted spot in sheet metal and will bond itself permanently. It can also be molded into any shape desired.

After application the plastic requires a brief drying period, approximately two hours, in which to become hard, tough and flexible, according to Bill Connor, North Side Chevrolet manager.

After becoming hard, Mr. Connor points out, the surface can be sanded smooth, filled, primed and painted just like metal. In addition it will not rust, rot or mildew.

Since it has a heavy ground aluminum content combined with a plastic binder or base, a thick
