

Manual Paper Gets High Award

Booster Named Tops in State

An all-American rating for superior journalistic achievement last semester has been awarded the Booster, Manual High School bi-weekly, by the National School Press Association.

The All-American rating, highest honor awarded by the association, was won by the Booster in the annual contest to choose the 22 best high school publications in its division in the United States. The Booster was the only Indiana paper in its division to achieve the rating.

Previously the bi-weekly had won the Quill and Scroll International Honor Rating, "A" award and Gallup Award. This is the first time it has won the All-American rating.

First prize of \$40 in the Indiana Society of Mayflower Descendants state essay contest has been won by Carolyn Marshall, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Marshall, 2233 Union St. Miss Marshall, Manual High School senior, read the essay before a meeting of the society.

Three Manual High School students have received special mention from the National High School Poetry Association for poems published in the "Annual Anthology of High School Poetry" for 1948.

The students are Keith Henselmeier, June Kennedy and Deloris Andrews.

The anthology previously accepted poetry by David Priest, Anna Perrone, C. D. Brooks, Leona Lair, Emma Behr, Iris Carman and Bella Eskenazi.


