

How To Use Voting Machines In Tomorrow's Primary

All Precincts In County Have Them

For the first time in history voting machines will be used in all precincts of Marion County for primary balloting tomorrow. In the municipal primary last year, voting machines were used in part of the precincts and paper ballots in the remainder. Use of voting machines in primary balloting will eliminate the tedious central counting at Tomlinson Hall where tabulations required four or five days.

Results of the balloting will be known three hours after the polls close.

Procedure Simple

Balloting for nominations in the party primaries on machines is a simple procedure.

Before you enter the booth you must tell the clerk what party you are voting, Republican or Democrat.

An election official then will turn a key on the outside of the machine to your party. This will lock all keys inside the machine on the opposition party candidates.

YOU CANNOT VOTE FOR CANDIDATES IN MORE THAN ONE PARTY.

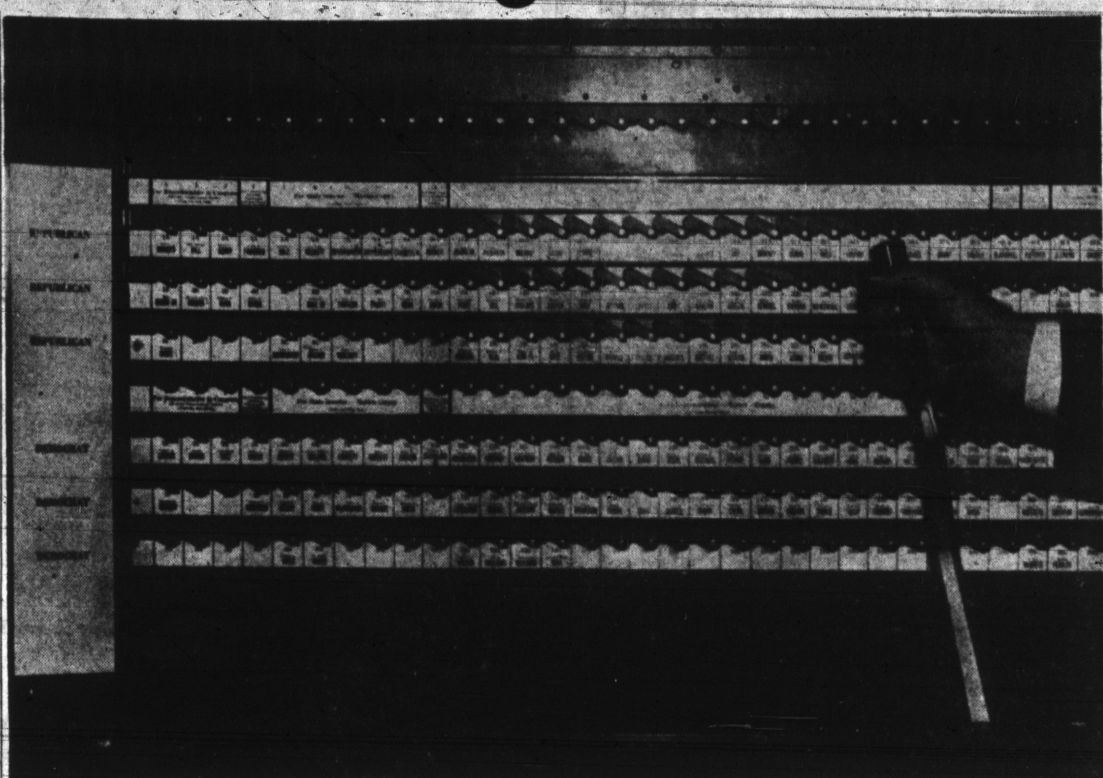
After entering the voting booth, pull the large, red-handled lever in the center of the machine all the way to the right. This closes the curtain around you and opens the keys of your party for voting.

Six Lines of Names

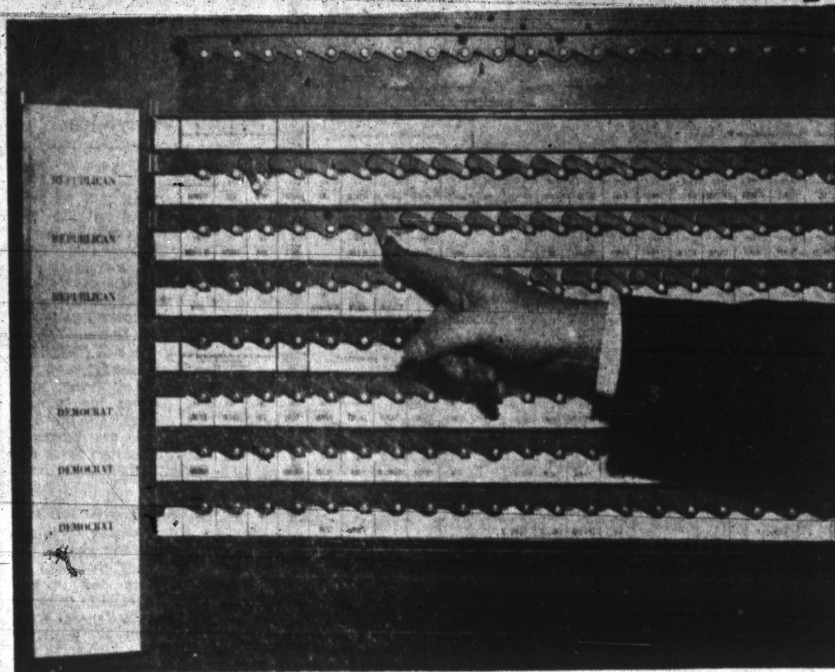
On the face of the machine are six lines of names all the way across. The top three lines are Republican candidates and the bottom three are Democrats.

Merely pick your candidates in your party you want nominated for the various offices and push down the little keys over their names.

Then, push the large red lever back to the left. This registers your vote and opens the curtain.



UNLOCKS MACHINE—This is the first thing you do after entering the voting machine booth tomorrow. Pull the large, red-handled lever in the center of the machine all the way to the right. This closes the curtain behind you and unlocks the keys over your party candidates.



VOTING FOR CANDIDATES—In primary voting you must designate the political party you are voting. An election official will turn a lever outside the machine, locking keys over the opposition party. Then, after unlocking the machine with the large lever, merely push down the small keys over the candidates you want nominated in your party as illustrated above.
