Trucking Firm Driver

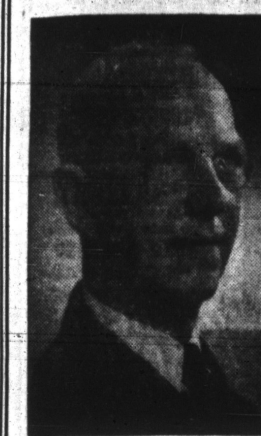
