10,000 Scouts to Present Circus Friday, Saturday

Indianapolis will see the reverse of juvenile delinquency when approximately 10,000 upstanding young Americans present their 1948 Scout Circus Friday and Saturday.

The show of eight major events will be given in the Indiana Fairgrounds Coliseum. All will depict pioneer or Indian life with the boys dressed either in the costumes of the early settlers or Indians.

Carl Parlasca, a nationally known authority on Indian lore and Scout executive of Elgin, Ill., arrived today to help local Scouts with circus preparations. Mr. Parlasca will direct the Indian pageant with which the circus opens.

10,000 to March

Edward Bruck will direct the grand entry; Don Esig, the city planning engineer, will be in charge of the parade; Harold Church, pioneer fun; O. A. Johnson, pioneer crafts; F. L. Layden, the senior scouting event; outdoor event, William Miller, and scout craft, Fred Lorenz, Lloyd Byrne will direct the circus for the sixth consecutive year and C. Otto Janus is general chairman.

The Indianapolis circus is part of a nation-wide scouting program which will come to a climax with a "Hoe Down" in June at Lake Geneva, Wis. Thirty-four scouts from here will represent Indianapolis troops. The national program is built around the theme of the book, "Boy of the Middle Border" by Hamlin Garland.

Will Show Crafts

The pioneer crafts act will include butter making, blacksmithing, rail splitting and many other industries of the early settlers. For the outdoor life event, boys will erect shelters and lean-tos. At each corner of the floor also, a signal tower will be set up and a demonstration of signaling will be given. Approximately 125 patrols will illustrate all phases of scout craft.

Horse Show Entries Reach All-Time High Today

Expect More Than 300 Animals to Compete; Entries Come in From Five States

The entry list for the Legion-Times Charity Horse Show at the Coliseum May 14, 15 and 16, stood at an all-time peak today with prospects that entries still in the mail would boost the total to more than 300 of the Midwest's finest show horses.

A count from horse show headquarters late yesterday afternoon revealed 280 entries already in, with letters and telegrams from out-of-state horse owners indicating their entries were mailed before the deadline last Friday midnight.

Previous high for entries in the spring event was 275 in 1946.

Swelling the list this year were strong entries in almost every class of competition from the four states adjacent to Indiana.

In addition to these entries from Michigan, Ohio, Illinois and Kentucky there were several from Missouri. More than half of the entries were from Indiana.

Pointing out that each of the 45 classes of horses to be shown received more than enough entries to assure strong competition for championship honors, Mrs. Marie M. Bowen, executive secretary of the Indiana Saddle Horse Association, said "we not only have the largest number but also the most outstanding array of horses ever entered."

Lobaugh Granted Execution Stay

Convicted Sex-Slayer Gets Third Reprieve

Ralph Lobaugh, 37-year-old former Kokomo factory worker convicted of slaying three Ft. Wayne women, had a six-month stay of execution today—the third time his execution date had been extended.

The State Supreme Court granted the stay late yesterday, postponing the scheduled May 24 electrocution until Nov. 15 to allow Lobaugh's attorneys time to prepare an appeal.

Several weeks ago, Allen Circuit Judge William Schannen at Ft. Wayne refused Lobaugh's plea for a new trial.

The Kokomo man pleaded guilty Oct. 27 to the sex slayings of Wilhelma Haaga, Dortha Howard and Anna Kuzef at Ft. Wayne during the war. Judge Schannen sentenced him to death.

Denies Guilty Plea

Later, however, Lobaugh denied guilt and explained his plea of guilty by saying he had a "spell." The original death date of Feb. 9 was extended to Apr. 2 and Judge Schannen then granted a stay until May 24, although he rejected the new trial petition.

The latest legal battle for Lobaugh's life was based partly on "truth serum" tests given the man at Indiana State Prison. Attorney Robert Butler contended the test indicated Lobaugh was innocent.
