## Gates to Nominate Local Rent Boards

**Answers NHA Request For More Members**  
 Gov. Gates said today he had complied with a request of T. H. E. Woods, National Housing Administrator, to nominate additional members for many of the state's local rent boards.  
 Pointing out that only Mr. Woods has final appointive power over the boards and that he simply nominates, the Governor said he was following the policy used since the start of the rent program and asking mayors of cities to nominate new board members. The Governor then relayed the nominations to the rent administration in Washington.  
 Mr. Woods asked for more equitable balance of renter and public interest in the members. He criticized the balance on such boards as that in Indianapolis which is made up of five landlord representatives, one tenant representative and two public interest members.

## Dad Forgives Son Who Shot Him

**Fired to Save Mother, Lad Tells Police**  
 James Hasch, 42-year-old Columbus, Ind. factory worker, was recovering at Long Hospital here today from a bullet wound in his head.  
 He was shot by his 13-year-old son, Roger Ellis Hasch, at the family home in Edinburg Sunday while the father was alleged to have been beating his wife, Dora.  
 "I couldn't stand any more of it," cried the son yesterday when telling police about the shooting.  
**Fires at Father**  
 He said his father was sitting on his mother beating and choking her when he got a 22-caliber rifle and fired at his father's head.  
 The bullet struck him below the left ear.  
 Police Chief Frank Andrews of Edinburg said he found Hasch still sitting on his wife on the floor half an hour after he had been shot.  
 Hasch said he didn't remember fighting with his wife.  
 "If it was my son who shot me, I forgive him," said the father in the hospital here today.
