TONIGHT AND TOMORROW—Cloudy weather with minimum temperatures in the 60s is forecast from New York to Atlanta and Memphis during the next 24 hours. Notice how southerly winds from the Gulf of Mexico are flowing over this part of the U. S. See that cool arrow up at the top center of the Fotocast. It shows the path of cool air flowing into the plains and the Upper Lakes Region. Weather Bureau experts say the mercury will drop into the 40s by dawn from Michigan through Wisconsin to the Dakotas. The affected areas show where rainy weather is probable. Showers and thunderstorms are indicated from New York through the Ohio and Tennessee Valleys to the Gulf coast.
