New Flood Crest Hits Oregon Dikes

PORLTAND, Ore., June 4 (UPI)—More troops and volunteers were thrown into the battle today to save the water-soaked Columbia River dikes which were threatened by a new crest sweeping down from the Rocky Mountains.

As the emergency crews fought against the new danger, the Red Cross reported that 13 persons, including 11 children, were listed tentatively as "unaccounted for" in the Vancou City tragedy last Sunday.

But, the Red Cross said, there was no definite proof that the 13 were dead.

LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
Notices are hereby given that the City Plan Commission, City of Indianapolis, proposes to file a petition with the City Court of Indianapolis, and the Common Council to General Ordinance No. 114, 1922 (as amended), as follows:

CAUSE No. 12-20: An amendment to change the zoning of the area bounded on the south by 18th Street, on the north by 19th Street, on the west by Harding Street and on the east by Sugar Grove Avenue, more particularly described in following:

Beginning at the intersection of the north property line of West Sixteenth Street and the east property line of North Harding Street, thence north on and along said east property line of North Harding Street to the south property line of West Eighteenth Street, thence east on and along said south property line of West Eighteenth Street to the west property line of North Sugar Grove Avenue, thence south on and along the west property line of North Sugar Grove Avenue to the north property line of West Sixteenth Street, thence west on and along said north property line of West Sixteenth Street to the place of beginning.

There are two parcels zoned U-1 or Residence Use, A-3 or 2400 square feet, in the district, H-1 or 50 feet length, district, H-1 or 50 feet width.

The requested amendment, if approved by the Common Council of the City of Indianapolis, will change the zoning from U-2 or Business Use, A-3 or 2600 square feet, in the district, H-1 or 50 feet height, district, H-1 or 50 feet width.

A public hearing will be held by the City Plan Commission in the room of the Indianapolis City Room 401, City Hall, at 3:30 P.M. on Monday, June 14, 1948, at which time and place the public will appear, will be given opportunity to be heard in reference to the proposed amendment. The public is invited to the Common Council for passage of this amendment if it decides favorably subsequent to the public hearing.
