Fear Demand To Remove UN

**Sidetrack Loan
For Building Fund**

LAKE SUCCOR, N. Y., June 15—The fact of the matter is this:

If Congress fails to pass the \$50 million American loan for the projected United Nations building in Manhattan, there most certainly will arise a demand to take the UN, bag and baggage, away from the United States.

The U. S. delegation here is acutely worried about the situation. So is Secretary General

Trygve Lie. They pray that somehow congressional leaders will realize the impact which would follow scuttling of the loan proposal at this session.

Soviets on Record

Russia and the Soviet yes-men already are on record to move the UN to Geneva or somewhere else in Europe.

And they know that a sizeable group of delegates, otherwise friendly to the Western powers, is wondering if the UN, in the long run, would not be better off in Europe.

The reasoning, as I get it from delegates here, is this:

They cannot understand why a matter so vital to the UN ever was allowed to get sidetracked in the first place.

The \$50 million was not a gift but a loan set up to finance the permanent UN site in the Turtle Bay area of Manhattan, on the East River near 42d St. It would be repaid to the U. S. Treasury over a period of years.

See Fears Revived

And so the question is raised: Is Congress making a political football of the UN loan as a slap to President Truman, who approved it in a pact with Trygve Lie?

Or what?

At any rate, judging by a fair cross-section of reactions here, possible sidetracking of the loan certainly revives fears that the United States is not devotedly interested in the welfare of the United Nations.

One diplomat gave me his idea of an alternative if Congress fails to act.

Why not use the machinery of the UN appeal for children campaign and ask the people of the world for contributions to get the new site built in New York?
