U. S. Funds Back Liberia Airline

New Project Develops From Stettinius Talks

NEW YORK, July 8—A new airline backed by American capital will begin operation this month in the Republic of Liberia and along the west coast of Africa.

It is part of a development program instituted by former Secretary of State Edward R. Stettinius to provide transportation from the hinterlands—where a wealth of natural resources awaits development—to the shipping centers.

The Liberian International Airways is a flagline chartered and backed by the Liberia Co., recently-formed development organization and brainchild of Mr. Stettinius, who is chairman of the board.

Operation base of the line is Roberts Field, outside of the capital of Monrovia. The air base was built by the United States during the war and became a vital stop-over point on overseas flights.




