How a small band of artillerymen withstood repeated assaults at Parkers Crossroads will be retold when the 106th "Golden Lion" Division stages its national convention here July 31 and Aug. 1.

An eyewitness account of the gallant stand at Baraque de Fraiture, Belgium, will be given by Major George Huxel, who was plans and training officer for the 589th Field Artillery Battalion.

Nearly 1000 members of Camp Atterbury, trained 106th, who are expected to attend the meetings in the Claypool Hotel, will hear the former officer tell of the battle with the Germans, which was led by Major Arthur C. Parker.

A graduate of Miami University, O., Mr. Huxel is now teaching mathematics and coaching football at East Cleveland, O. He joined the Golden Lions at Atterbury in 1944.
