Suspect Arsonist In Mystery Fires

Marshal Expects Arrest by Nightfall

MACOMB, Ill., Aug. 30 (UP)—Deputy State Fire Marshal John Burgard said tonight that by nightfall he will "put the finger" on the arsonist who set hundreds of fires that burned down Charley Willey's home from one farm to another.

Marshal Burgard said that he had broken the mystery of why fires "shot out of walls like lighted gas out of a blow torch," burned down Mr. Willey's house and two barns, then broke out again in the vacant farmhouse where he and his family took refuge.

Willey's in Clear

"The fires were set by an arsonist," State Fire Marshal John Craig agreed. "We know who he is and we're trying to get evidence that will stand up in court."

Marshal Craig said that the suspected arsonist had refused to take a lie detector test when questioned. He said that it was not any member of Mr. Willey's family. Mr. Willey, himself, was hopeful that his troubles would soon end.

"Willey's in the clear, and he's still planning to rebuild on his old place," Marshal Burgard said.
