

# Conservation Meetings Are On Docket

## New Legislation Up For Discussion

With the State Fair folding and the weathermen's "scattered showers" muddying most of the streams, Hoosier conservationists are turning their attention to statewide meetings scheduled this week-end and next.

Officers, directors and committee members of Conservation United are staging a "pow-wow" this week-end at Tippecanoe River State park to formulate plans for an intense membership campaign and other fall activities.

Next week-end the members of the State Conservation Advisory Committee and delegates from each county are scheduled to meet at Morgan-Monroe state forest for an annual session at which operations of the department, legislative proposals and suggestions from local clubs will be reviewed.

## Both Sessions Important

Since this is an election year and the General Assembly will meet in January both of the week-end gatherings will hold more than usual significance. Both the Democratic and Republican state platforms contain planks expressing party support of the conservation program.

Both the Advisory Committee and Conservation United which has been sparking a revival of interest in conservation activities, are backing a measure which would take the Conservation Officers out of politics and place the enforcement staff of the department under a merit system similar to that of the state police. Each group also has other legislative proposals which have wide support among hunters and fishermen.

## Plan Campaign

Conservation United leaders meeting this week-end at Tippecanoe State Park will center their attention on mapping an aggressive campaign for members. Carl Lee Compton, state president, announced today.

While the conference opens Saturday, no formal program has been arranged until Sunday morning when the officers and directors will convene at 9 a. m. Chairmen of the committees named several weeks ago by President Compton will report at this time.

Proposals for new conservation legislation and revising of existing statutes will be received during the session but formal acceptance of these will await a study of the proposals by the organization's officers and policy committee.

## Attendance Restricted

Due to the limited accommodations available at Morgan-Monroe state forest, attendance at the session of the State Conservation Advisory Committee is restricted to two persons per county. M. L. Davis, secretary of the organization, has announced.

The gathering will get under way with a dinner at 6 p. m. on Sept. 15, followed by a general meeting which will close at 9:15 to permit a session of the advisory group. On Sunday morning a tour of the forest, following breakfast, is the only event scheduled with the adjournment scheduled for 11 o'clock.

The Saturday night session will include reports on activities of the department, the presentation of recommendations from local clubs and a discussion of general conservation policies.

## Odds 'n' Ends

Divisions of General Motors are credited by Wildlife Management Institute with taking positive steps to prevent stream pollution—bridges are being built over steep irrigation ditches in the state of Washington for deer and elk, many of which had been trapped in the ditches and fallen easy prey to hunters. Last year's fur catch was the lowest in seven years, according to reports on purchases of pelts by licensed fur buyers. Topographic maps, now available for 125 57-square mile quadrangles, could be useful to hunters venturing into unfamiliar territory. William Barnes, director of the Pittman-Robertson project since its start in Indiana, will represent the fish and game division in the new co-operative study of wildlife to be made by Purdue University.

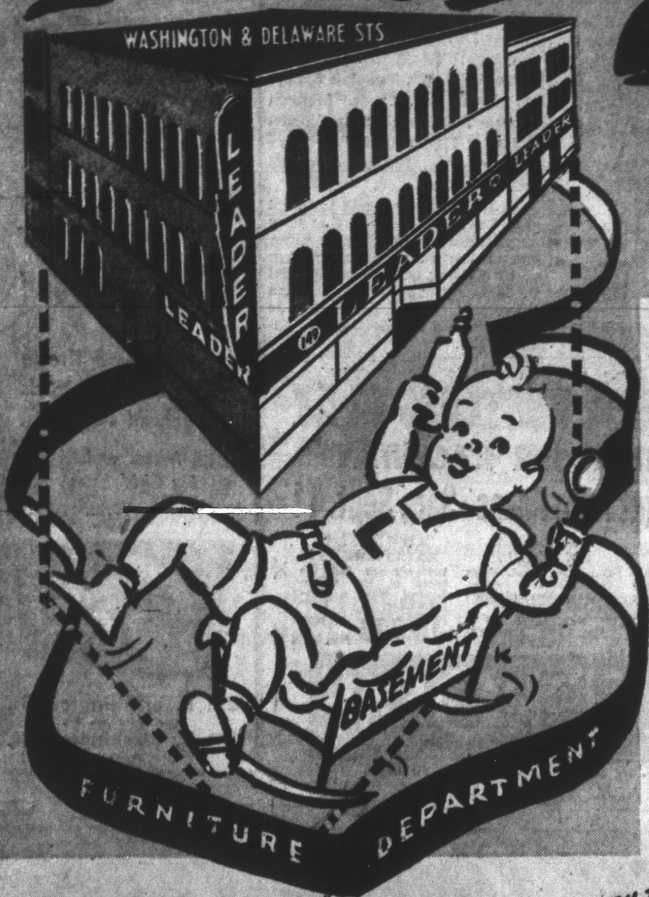

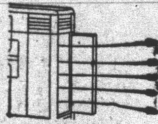

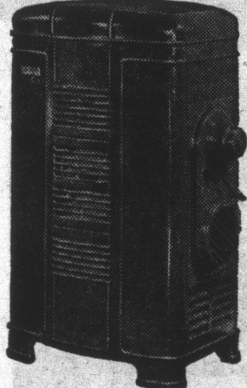
