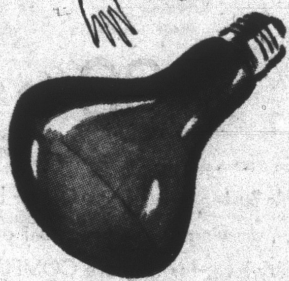

Muncie Worker
Declared FreeArkansas Extradition
Denied by Gates

John Ware, Muncie foundry worker sought by Arkansas as a parole violator, is a free man at last.

Gov. Gates yesterday reversed an earlier decision and denied extradition of the Muncie Negro to Arkansas after The Times told Mr. Ware's story. His action followed a Delaware Circuit Court decision holding that Mr. Ware was not a fugitive from justice and that Arkansas had no claim on him.

Until Wednesday, Mr. Ware had been held in protective custody in Muncie after charging Arkansas authorities virtually kidnapped him to bring him to Indianapolis for extradition proceedings. The Governor issued an extradition warrant about three weeks ago but withdrew it after Mr. Ware's charge was made to await court developments.

Muncie Record Good
The Muncie man was convicted of shooting a white man who came to his farm in Arkansas years ago. He served 10 years and then was paroled to a sponsor for whom he had to work for \$1.50 a day.

Under the impression that his parole period was for only six months, he came to Muncie about two years ago where he established a record as a church-going, hard-working citizen.

In denying extradition, Gov. Gates held that while a governor had no authority to dig into the merits of Mr. Ware's trial and parole in Arkansas, the court had such authority. He pointed out in his statement denying the warrant that the court apparently had found grounds for its ruling that Mr. Ware was not a fugitive from justice and that he had not violated his Arkansas parole.

2-A-Day Cigars
Keeps Baby Happy

SPRINGFIELD, Mass., Sept. 10 (UP)—Mrs. Lawrence Phillips was resigned today to her 22-month-old son's habit of smoking 12-cent cigars.

She said the baby, Lawrence Jr., began smoking cigars a year ago, but switched to cigars last month. Two a day.

"We used to think it was cute," she said. "I don't like it now, but he squawks and carries on something fierce if I don't give him his cigars."

At least, she said, he's a gentleman about it. "He always uses the ash tray," she said.

Dog Shooter
Fined \$100 HereFired at Animals
Entering His Yard

Floyd G. Dunham, 34, of R. R. 13, Box 34, was fined \$100 and costs and given a suspended 10-day jail sentence by Municipal Judge Alex Clark yesterday on charges of shooting dogs.

Dunham admitted he wounded one dog with a shotgun and killed another when a pack of dogs attempted to enter his chicken yard Aug. 14. He explained he killed the dog because it was suffering after he wounded it. Two days later, he said he wounded another dog.

Took No Action
Dunham, who was tried on cruelty to animals charges, said that he shot the dogs to protect his property and to determine "who their owners were."

He admitted that he had not notified the sheriff that the dogs were a nuisance and took no legal action to prevent the animals from running loose.

Charges were brought by Jack Coburn, R. R. 13, Box 19, whose dog was killed; Albert Walls, R. R. 13, Box 13, and Gilbert Swaney, R. R. 13, Box 15, whose dogs were wounded by shotgun pellets.

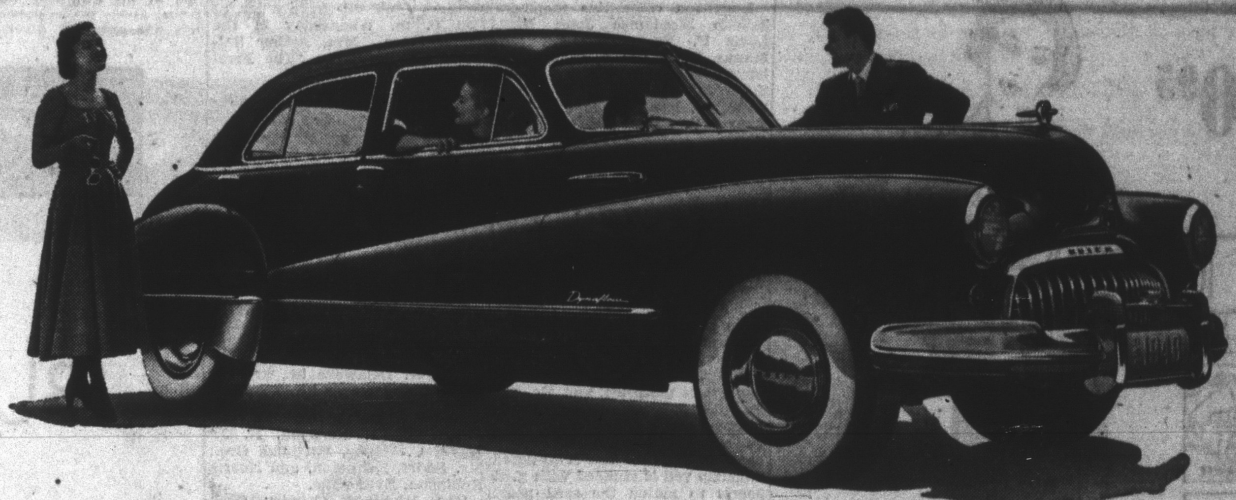
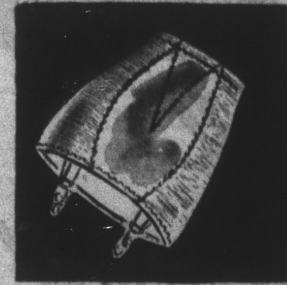
